LATE NIGHT LOUD MUSIC PROBLEM

Hello Sir/Madam.

My partner, myself, plus many of my neighbours, have grave concerns regarding PLANNING APPLICATION TO EXTEND EXCISTING MUSIC LICENCE TO BOLD PRIVATEER PUB article which was printed in the local newspaper T & A. (The mandatory blue notice which is supposed to be fastened to the nearest lamp post to notify the general public and closest living neighbours, appears to be inside the pub and is not visible to passing public.)

The planning application notice, <u>Punch</u>, who own the pub, has requested is to extend the entertainment license from <u>10:00 to 01:00</u> the following morning !! Which is very unfair to the surrounding neighbours. We can be sat in our house with doors and windows closed and can still hear it above the TV.

We live across from The Bold Privateer in a residential area of Wrose Road, Shipley, surrounded with lots of families with children living in very close proximaty.

This pub was previously run as a community pub with live entertainment & music events, and the previous landlady was very considerate towards the neighbours, the doors and windows were be kept <u>closed</u> to reduce the decibels of the music, and no one allowed to drink outside after 22:00

BUT SINCE the renovation, it is now having live entertainment which is far too loud every weekend, even if it is live OR recorded as this is just as loud. As I understood the stipulations on the <u>original</u> licence for live/recorded music were from 10am till <u>23:00 prompt</u>, they go way past sometimes till nearly <u>24:00</u>. The so called community pub, is no longer for the locals, but is now a sports/wine bar by day and a <u>NIGHTCLUB</u> at night. Revellers are still leaving the premises by taxis, shouting and banging doors at <u>02:00</u> and sometimes later in the early hours of the morning.

We do not want to spoil anyone's enjoyment but the noise is unbearable especially late at night weekends and Monday nights when motorbike clubs meet and sit revving their bikes as late as 22:00-22:30. Currently the noise issue is only a problem on Monday, Friday and Saturday nights but as far as I am aware the licence does not restrict music to weekends only.

Please could you consider the surrounding neighbours and refuse this application, a residential area with young families is not the area for a <u>NIGHTCLUB</u>.

Dear Sir/Madam

I am writing in response to a letter received from our local councillors regarding a planning application from the Bold Privateer to extend the hours for live music Friday and Saturday from 2300 until 0000 and recorded music Friday and Saturday from 2300 until 0100.

The village of Wrose does not require a late night/early morning music licence for a local public house. This is a residential area and I do not feel that allowing this application would be conducive to the health and wellbeing of the local population, made up of working parents, young children, older people and people with disabilities and/or illness.

Our house is at the back and to the side of the pub and the music will hit our property directly, particularly when the Bold Privateer rear window is open. My husband has now been retired from work on ill health grounds, is in receipt of Personal Independent Payment and is reliant on medication to help him sleep. Being woken by noise and disturbance at such late hours will cause him great distress.

Our daughter, who is currently undergoing chemotherapy treatment for an autoimmune disease, is a shift worker and requires an unbroken sleep as she commutes to Manchester for her work with HMRC. This could not be guaranteed if the music licence was granted and the possibility of late night/early hours of the morning commotion.

Like other parts of the Bradford Metropolitan district there is increasing anti/unsocial activity in this area of the village – of which the police, local councillors and our MP are acutely aware. To have this behaviour potentially supported by the local public house to continue into the early hours at weekends due to longer licensing hours would be too much to tolerate.

To (mis)use a quote from local council officers as printed in the T&A on 10 August 2016 about a recent application for a licence in Saltaire: A drinking establishment with music till 1am every weekend is not acceptable in this location due to potential adverse impact on residential amenity as a result of the noise and disturbance to surrounding residents.

Thank you for taking my opinions into account in this matter. I was born in Wrose and have lived in this house for over 30 years, so feel qualified to express myself and my experience regarding this matter.


