

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER  
[IMPORTANT – THIS COMMUNICATION AFFECTS YOUR PROPERTY]**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
CITY OF BRADFORD METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COUNCIL  
PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY No 54 (SHIPLEY)  
WROSE BROW ROAD, SHIPLEY**

On 19<sup>th</sup> January 2023, the City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council confirmed the above Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public bridleway commencing at Point A and continuing in a generally northern direction for approximately 100 metres to Point B at its junction with Wrose Brow Road, Shipley and create a new bridleway commencing at Point A and continuing in a generally easterly direction for approximately 313 metres to Point E at its junction with Wrose Brow Road as shown on the attached plan no. 66645/T34/Diversion Order Plan.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed on deposit and may be seen free of charge at Customer Services, Ground Floor, City Hall, Bradford BD1 1HY and at Shipley Library during normal opening hours or may be examined on the Council's website at <https://bradford.moderngov.uk/mgConsultationListDisplay.aspx>.

The Order comes into force on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2023, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 26<sup>th</sup> January 2023, make an application to the High Court.

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER  
SECTION 119 HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

**CITY OF BRADFORD METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COUNCIL**

**PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY No 54 (SHIPLEY)  
WROSE BROW ROAD, SHIPLEY**

This Order is made by City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner and occupier of the land crossed by the bridleway described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the public bridleway should be diverted.

The Council has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the bridleway into a fit condition for use by the public.

**BY THIS ORDER**

- 1 The public right of way over the land situated at Wrose Brow Road, Shipley, shown by bold a continuous line between Points A and B on the map contained in this Order and described in Part I of the Schedule to this Order shall be diverted after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
- 2 Notwithstanding this Order all statutory undertakers shall retain all existing rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 above namely the rights to access their apparatus for the purpose of maintenance replacement or renewal.
- 3 There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public bridleway over the land situated at Wrose Brow Road, Shipley, described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken line between Points A and E on the map contained in this Order.

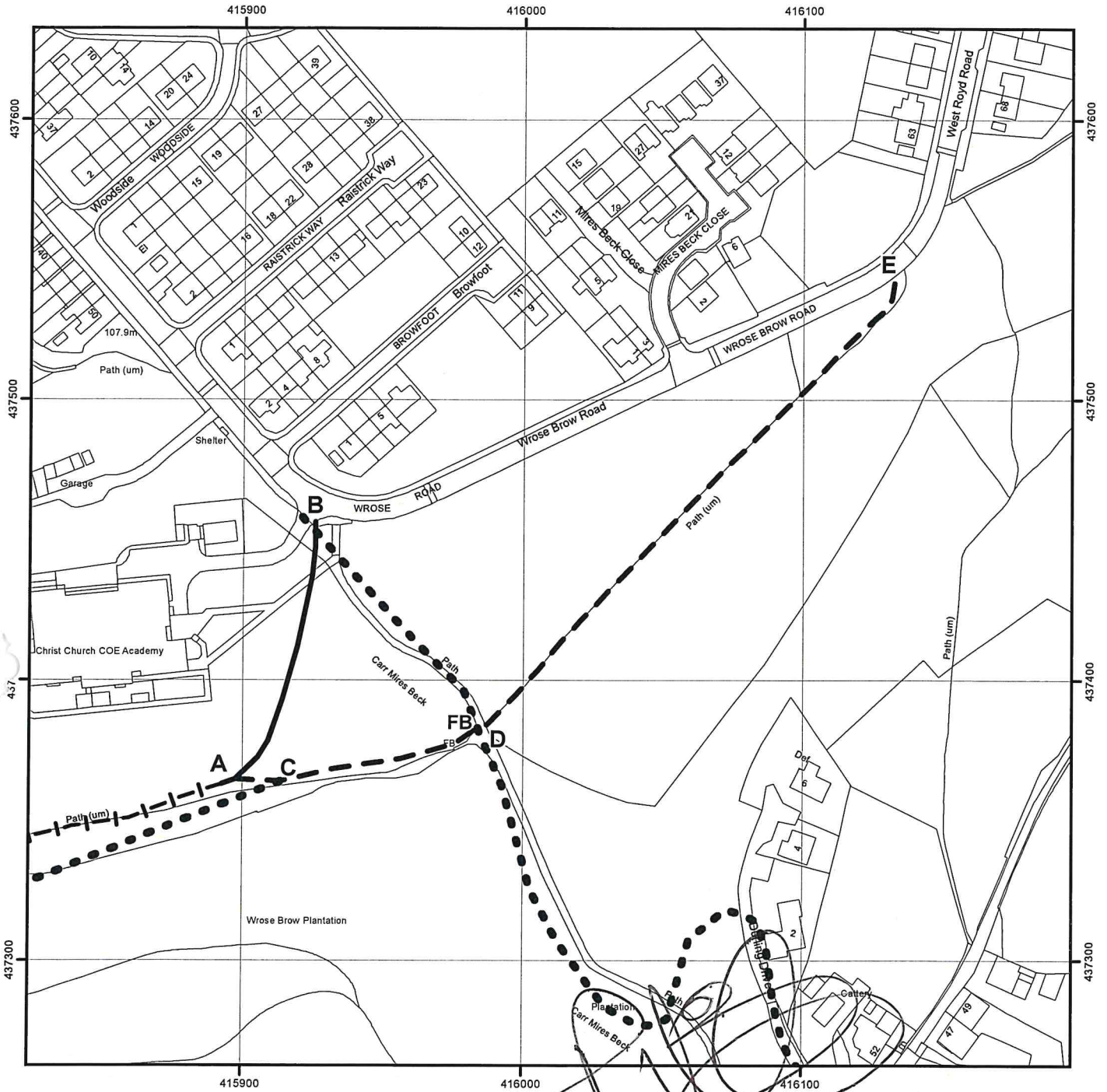

in a generally northerly direction for approximately 100 metres to Point B (Grid Ref SE 1592 3745) at its junction with Wrose Brow Road.

The existing route has a recorded width of 3 metres with a grassed surface.

## PART 2

### DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A-C-D-E Public Bridleway No 54 (Shipley) as shown marked with a black dashed line on the map annexed hereto commencing at Point A (Grid Ref SE1589 3736) and continuing in a generally easterly direction for approximately 88 metres via Point C (Grid Ref 1590 3736) to Point D (Grid Ref 1598 3738) at its junction with Public Footpath No 10 (Shipley) then continuing further in a north easterly direction for approximately 225 metres to Point E (Grid Ref SE1619 3754) at its junction with Wrose Brow Road.


The new route will have a recorded width of 3 metres and a stoned and grassed surface and includes a bridge over Carr Mires Beck shown marked FB on the map annexed hereto.

All distances are as measured on the ground.
