**105160 HAINWORTH ROAD, KEIGHLEY**

Notice is hereby given that City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council made the above Order on 18<sup>th</sup> May 2023 under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to introduce the following: -

**I. Prohibition of Driving (Access Only) on a length of Hainworth Road, Keighley.**

The Order comes into force on 29<sup>th</sup> May 2023 and a copy of the Order together with a map showing the affected roads may be examined during normal office hours at the Customer Services Reception, City Hall, Bradford, BD1 1HY and at or at Keighley Town Hall, Bow Street, Keighley BD21 3PA or examined on the Council's' website at <https://www.bradford.gov.uk/transport-and-travel/highways/traffic-regulation-order> or obtained from Chris Hird, Traffic Engineer – Place, by telephone on 01535 618172 or by email, [chris.hird@bradford.gov.uk](mailto:chris.hird@bradford.gov.uk) quoting reference number P/HS/THN/105160/CON-1A.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or of any Instrument made under it, have not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the date upon which the Order was made 18<sup>th</sup> May 2023 apply to the High Court for this purpose.



The City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984” and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 “the Act of 2004” and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:

1. In this Order, the expression “enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council (Moving Traffic) (Consolidation) Order 2009 hereinafter referred to as “the Consolidation Order” shall have effect as though:
  - (a) There were added to that Order:
    - (i) In Schedule 13 the items numbered 213 set out in Schedule 13A to this Order.
3. Designation of Restrictions and application of the Consolidation Order, where applicable: -
  - (a) The provisions of the Consolidation Order shall apply to any area designated as a prohibited movement, mandatory movement, prohibition of vehicles, bus priority measure, pedal cycle measure or pedestrian zone by this Order, as if in those provisions any reference to a prohibited movement, mandatory movement, prohibition of vehicles, bus priority measure, pedal cycle measure or pedestrian zone included a reference to an area designated as a prohibited movement, mandatory movement, prohibition of vehicles, bus priority measure, pedal cycle measure or pedestrian zone by this Order and as if any reference to a Schedule to the Consolidation Order included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.
4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to:
  - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
  - (b) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
  - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

5. This Order is made on the 18th day of May 2023 and shall come into force on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of May 2023 and may be cited as the City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council (Moving Traffic) (Consolidation) (Amendment No.3) Order 2023.
