STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

Bradford Council, in partnership with the West Yorkshire Combined Authority, are proposing The Bradford City Centre Walking and Cycling Improvements Scheme which aims to reshape Bradford city centre by improving walking and cycling routes, removing traffic from some roads, and introducing new green outdoor spaces for people to enjoy.

To help deliver a safe environment for walking and cycling in the City Centre the Council is promoting this Traffic Regulation Order to provide: -

- Proposed prohibited left turns from Kirkgate onto Sunbridge Road and Sunbridge Road onto Godwin Street.
- Proposed road closures on Market Street, Bank Street, Broadway, Bridge Street and parts of Hall Ings.
- Proposed bus lanes on Well Street, Godwin Street, Princes Way, Manchester Road, Hall Ings and Vicar Lane

The Council considers it expedient to make this Order:-

- for facilitating the passage on the road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians);
- ii. for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs and;
- iii. for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising;
