(WAITING LOADING AND PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (AMENDMENT NO. **) ORDER 202*

VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN THE BRADFORD EAST CONSTITUENCY STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council has received a number of requests to amend, add or remove waiting restrictions at various locations throughout the Bradford East Area Constituency.

The proposed Traffic Regulation Order will introduce waiting restrictions at a number of locations identified to improve road safety and assist the passage of traffic. The proposals are also designed to improve traffic management generally.

The majority of these restrictions will be No Waiting At Any Time Restrictions (NWAAT) which will operate 24 hours a day. These restrictions are being proposed to carry out several tasks, including maintaining and increasing visibility at junctions, making it easier for drivers to navigate roads and reducing the risk of conflict between drivers on narrow road.

There are also two schemes within this project which will be reducing the severity or number of waiting restrictions within them. This is to allow parking in sections where we have judged that the NWAAT can be relaxed. One will be relaxing sections of NWAAT to No Waiting Mon-Fri 8am-6pm. The other will be revoking sections of NWAAT leaving these sections unrestricted.

The proposals are shown in detail on the attached drawings.

The Council considers it expedient to make this Order:-

- i. for facilitating the passage on the road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians);
- ii. for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs; and
- iii. for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
