1. SUMMARY

This report provides an update on the allocation of Youth Opportunities Funding and Children and Young People's Community Chest Funding.

2. BACKGROUND

A report was presented to the Bradford East Area Committee on 17th September 2014 in relation to Youth Opportunities Funding and Children and Young Peoples Community Chest Funding – Document O. The Bradford East Area Committee resolved that:

- (1) That a Grants Advisory Group made up of the Chair, Deputy Chair and a member from the other largest group represented on the Committee be established.
- (2) That the Bradford East Area Committee delegates decisions about the allocation of the Youth Opportunities Funding and Children and Young Peoples Community Chest Funding, to the Area Co-ordinator, in consultation with the Grants Advisory Group. The decisions of the Area Co-ordinator should be reported to the Area Committee at its next available meeting.

Youth Opportunities Funding

A Youth Opportunities Fund Area Panel was set up to consider applications. This Panel was made up of young people from across the Bradford East Area, supported by Youth Workers. They presented their recommendations to the Grants Advisory Group and the Area Co-ordinator at a meeting on 18th November 2014. A list of organisations granted funding is attached as Appendix A (Youth Opportunities Funding). All of this funding, £10,000, was fully allocated.

Children and Young People's Community Chest

An amount of £500 became available to reallocate as a previous application, reference CYPCC/09/14 to East Bowling All Stars to deliver football provision, was returned as the group folded. The Grants Advisory Group allocated this £500 to Quest Taekwondo Thorpe Edge towards purchasing equipment. This funding pot is therefore still fully allocated.

3. OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

There are no other considerations for this report.

4. FINANCIAL & RESOURCE APPRAISAL

£10,000 Youth Opportunities Funding was available to the Bradford East Area Committee for 2014 / 2015. This funding should be spent by 31st March 2015.

Staffing: Support is provided from within the existing resources of Neighbourhood and Customer Services, other Council Services and partners.

There are no significant risks arising out of the proposed recommendations in this Report.
