# Subject:

Petition requesting additional on-street short stay limited waiting parking provision within close proximity of the shops on High Street, Wibsey on Oakroyd Road has been received.

#### 1 SUMMARY

1.1 This report considers the 27 signatories, supporting this petition for additional short stay on-street limited waiting parking provision on Oakroyd Road, Wibsey.

#### 2 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 High Street, between Folly Hall Road/Fair Road and Smith Road has waiting restrictions on both sides. In 2010/11 additional measures were introduced on Oakroyd Road which included no waiting at any time restrictions, on-street limited waiting parking provision of 2 hours on Mondays to Saturdays for 2 vehicles and a permit parking zone for the residents.
- 2.2 The additional measures introduced in 2010/11 and existing measures which have been introduced in Wibsey can be seen on Appendix 1, which shows the extents of the different types of measure within Wibsey.
- 2.3 The petition is supported by 17 of the businesses on this section of High Street, it has suggested that additional parking provision is provided short stay parking on Oakroyd Road by moving the start of the residents permit parking zone further down Oakroyd Road. The suggestion is also supported by a number of businesses on Fair Road and Folly Hall Road.
- As a result of the petition a study/review has been carried out in the area shown in Appendix 1, as a result of this the suggested measure shown in Appendix 2 were prepared for the Ward Councillors consideration and the Wibsey Urban Village. Following the meeting of the Wibsey Urban Village Appendix 3 has been produced which would also deal with immediate concerns raised by the petition and the meeting.
- 2.5 A copy of the petition will be made available for inspection on the day of the committee.

# 3. OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

3.1 The Ward councillors supported the draft proposals shown in Appendix 2, prior to them being considered by the local businesses at Wibsey Urban Village on the 28<sup>th</sup> February. Councillor Lynne Smith has been sent a copy of the final proposals shown in Appendix 3 and is happy for these measures to be considered along with the petition in addressing the current problems.

4.1 That the final proposal shown in Appendix 3 be accepted as the appropriate measures to address the petition and businesses concerns in the short term and consider this for processing of a Traffic Regulation Order when future resources become available.






