42. DISCLOSURES OF INTEREST

The following disclosures of interest were received:

- (i) Councillor Walls disclosed a disclosable pecuniary interest in the item relating to Ward Budgets (Minute 48) as his son was employed as a band teacher at Foxhill Primary School, one of the organisations that had requested funding and he left the meeting during consideration of that item.
- (ii) Councillor L Cromie disclosed a disclosable pecuniary interest in the item relating to Ward Budgets (Minute 48) as she was a Member of Queensbury Historic Society, one of the organisations that had requested funding and she left the meeting during consideration of that item.
- (iii) In the interest of transparency Councillor Ferriby disclosed an interest in the item relating to Traffic Regulation Orders (Minute 46) as the scheme pertaining to New Works Road was on the road she resided on, however the scheme was not recommended for approval at this stage.

The Advanced Youth Work Practitioner was present at the meeting, together with a number of youth workers, and gave a comprehensive overview of youth work in the Bradford South area which was detailed in Document “AA”.

During the discussion Members endorsed the excellent work done by the Youth Service in their respective Wards, in particular the collaborative work undertaken with the Neighbourhoods Service and the Police and Community Support Officers.

Resolved -

That the Bradford South Youth Service be thanked for providing a helpful and descriptive report and the young people for attending the meeting, and that an Annual Report on the Youth Service be presented in the New Year.

46. **BRADFORD SOUTH AREA – All Wards in VARIOUS SITES TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER Bradford South**

The Strategic Director Regeneration and Culture submitted a report (**Document “AB”**) which sought approval to process a Traffic Regulation Order to introduce parking restrictions at various locations in Bradford South.

In response to a question on when the Orders would be processed, the Strategic Director stated that it would take about 6-9 months to process the Orders.

A Member suggested the inclusion of a scheme on Priestley Terrace, Wibsey subject to a contribution from the Ward Fund.

Resolved -

- (1) That the Traffic Regulation Order for waiting restrictions at various locations in Bradford South be approved, as detailed in paragraph 2.2 of Document “AB”, and subject to suitable additional ward funding being provided for a scheme on Priestley Terrace, Wibsey as detailed in Appendix 1 to Document “AB”.**

- (2) That any valid objections be reported to this Area Committee for consideration or, in the event of there being no valid objections, the Order be sealed and implemented as advertised.

47. WENBOROUGH LANE, HOLME WOOD – PETITION

The Strategic Director Regeneration and Culture submitted a report (**Document “AC”**) which set out at a petition requesting the closure of Wenborough Lane, Holme Wood to prevent through traffic, and boundary fencing works on nearby open land to prevent anti-social activity.

The Strategic Director highlighted that following a traffic survey on Wenborough Lane, the traffic generated was very low and therefore a road closure would have a detrimental impact on residents and visitors. In addition work had been done to secure an area of land in the vicinity of Wenborough Lane as there had been issue with motorcycles and quad bikes accessing this land.

Resolved -

- (1) That no further action be taken on the request for a closure on Wenborough Lane.
- (2) That the Bradford South Area Committee welcomes the ongoing works to prevent vehicular access to open land adjacent to Wenborough Lane.
- (3) That the petitioners are informed accordingly.
