A. PROCEDURAL ITEMS

1. **ALTERNATE MEMBERS** (Standing Order 34)

The City Solicitor will report the names of alternate Members who are attending the meeting in place of appointed Members.

2. **DISCLOSURES OF INTEREST**

(Members Code of Conduct - Part 4A of the Constitution)

To receive disclosures of interests from members and co-opted members on matters to be considered at the meeting. The disclosure must include the nature of the interest.

An interest must also be disclosed in the meeting when it becomes apparent to the member during the meeting.

Notes:

- (1) Members may remain in the meeting and take part fully in discussion and voting unless the interest is a disclosable pecuniary interest or an interest which the Member feels would call into question their compliance with the wider principles set out in the Code of Conduct. Disclosable pecuniary interests relate to the Member concerned or their spouse/partner.
- (2) Members in arrears of Council Tax by more than two months must not vote in decisions on, or which might affect, budget calculations, and must disclose at the meeting that this restriction applies to them. A failure to comply with these requirements is a criminal offence under section 106 of the Local Government Finance Act 1992.
- (3) Members are also welcome to disclose interests which are not disclosable pecuniary interests but which they consider should be made in the interest of clarity.
- (4) Officers must disclose interests in accordance with Council Standing Order 44.

3. INSPECTION OF REPORTS AND BACKGROUND PAPERS

(Access to Information Procedure Rules – Part 3B of the Constitution)

Reports and background papers for agenda items may be inspected by contacting the person shown after each agenda item. Certain reports and background papers may be restricted.

Any request to remove the restriction on a report or background paper should be made to the relevant Director or Assistant Director whose name is shown on the front page of the report.

If that request is refused, there is a right of appeal to this meeting.

B. BUSINESS ITEMS

4. BRADFORD YOUTH OFFER REVIEW

The Strategic Director of Children's Services will submit **Document "AG"** which informs the Committee of the outcome following the Council commissioned independent review of Bradford's Youth Provisions.

The review undertook an analysis of existing and potential service arrangements and the views of young people and key stakeholders to inform a set of recommendations on how best to develop a new Youth Offer in the District. The report summarises the findings of the review, the totality of the current youth offer for young people and the range of places to go and things to do/available in the District.

Recommended-

- (1) That Members consider the findings of the Youth Offer Review.
- (2) That Members comment and make recommendations to Executive on the desire to sustain and develop the Youth Offer in the District ensuring a more strategic collaboration of public, voluntary, community, uniformed and faith sector providers and increased Youth Voice that enables participation at a strategic level as part of the wider youth voice offer.
