The application is for the grant of a Premises Licence for the sale/supply of alcohol off the premises.

Staff training on licence issues.

2. Relevant Representations Received

2.1 Interested Parties

Local Residents/Business – A petition and letter of representation have been received. The representations raise concerns of underage drinking and possible anti-social behaviour. Concerns are also raised about additional waste problems.

Members may wish to consider whether the following streets are in the vicinity of the premises in order for the representations to be valid;

Hall Road/Midway Ave/Lysander Way/Hollings St/Heights Lane/Sandymoor/Main Street, Wilsden/Littlelands/Eaton Court/Stone Court/North Cres/Queens Road/Beckfield Road/Merrivale Road/Prospect Mount/Stirrow St/Nab Wood Mount/Dorset St/Roundhill Ave/Fernbank Dve/Sapgate Lane, Thornton/ Birchlands Ave/Low Wood/Warren Lane/Glen Mount/Maddocks St/Westwood Cres/ Worthfield Cres/Eastwood Cres/John's Court/Oberon Way/Reay St/Stainbeck Close/Bradford Old Rd/Crownest Rd/Marmion, Allerton/Manorley Lane, Shelf/ Powell Road, Bingley/Fairy Dell/Albert St, Wilsden/High Fold, East Morton/ Cottingley Rd, Sandy Lane,/Stone St/Hillfoot/Norman St/New Brighton.

Also, 20 of the petitioners have not given a full postal address.

The letter and petition are attached at Appendix 2.

3. Legal Appraisal

- 3.1 The Licensing Act 2003 requires the Council to carry out its various licensing functions so as to promote the following four licensing objectives:
 - a) the prevention of crime and disorder
 - b) public safety
 - c) the prevention of public nuisance
 - d) the protection of children from harm
- 3.2 The Council must also have regard to the guidance issued by the Department of Culture Media and Sport under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003. Regard must also be taken of the Council's statement of Licensing Policy for the District.
- 3.3 Where it is decided it is necessary to depart from the statutory guidance or the Licensing Policy on the merits of a particular case; then special reasons justifying this must be given that can be sustained.
- 3.4 Only "relevant representations" by or expressly on behalf of a defined "interested party" or "responsible authority" can be taken into account. In order to be "relevant" a representation must fairly relate to achieving a licensing objective. If it does not, it must be discounted.
- 3.5 Any licensing conditions that Members may propose attaching must also relate to achieving one of the licensing objectives; be tailored to the actual premises and

style of licensable activity; must be reasonably achievable by the applicant and in his/her control.

4. Statement of Policy Issues

- 4.1 The following parts of the Licensing Policy are of particular importance; Part 4 (prevention of crime and disorder) and Part 6 (prevention of Public Nuisance).
- 4.2 The Annexes to the Policy sets out various types of model condition that could be considered.

5. Legal Options

- 5.1 Members may:
 - (a) Grant a premises licence as applied for subject to any mandatory conditions and the precautions specified in the operating schedule submitted.
 - (b) Grant a premises licence subject to such additional conditions relating to achievement of the licensing objectives as members think fit; or
 - (c) Refuse the application for a premises licence.
- 5.2 Should the applicant or any other party to the hearing feel aggrieved at any decision with regard to the licence or to any conditions or restrictions attached by Members they may appeal to the Magistrates Court.

6. Financial and resource appraisal

6.1 There are no apparent finance or resource implications.

7. Other implications

7.1 Equal Rights

There are no apparent equal rights implications.

7.3 Community safety implications

There are no apparent community safety implications.

7.4 Human Rights Act

The following rights are applicable:

Article 1 First Protocol to the Convention – Right to peaceful enjoyment of possessions subject to the state's right to control the use of property in accordance with the general interest. The Council's powers set out in the recommendations fall within the states right. A fair balance must be struck between public safety and the applicant's rights.

Article 6 – A procedural right to a fair hearing. As refusal of the application is an option, adherence to the Panels' usual procedure of affording a hearing to the applicant is very important. The applicant should also be able to examine the requirements of the fire authority. If the decision is to refuse then reasons should be given.

OBJECTION

I am writing to OBJECT to the above application as the opening of an additional off licence in the vicinity would only promote and encourage underage drinking and anti-social behaviour, therefore, increasing the level of crime and disorder in the surrounding area.

I object strongly to the application on the basis that the area, which already has an off-licence, will be inundated with teenagers trying to purchase alcohol for under age drinking.

I also object on the grounds for 'Prevention of Crime and Disorder' and further on the grounds for 'Protection of children from harm.'

My wife and I have been running our family business for 26 years, and have built up relationships with customers. Our children have grown up with other children within the area.

We have excellent knowledge of those who are at the legal age to buy alcohol and those who are not, something that cannot be said about 'Village Superstore'.

I would like to object not only on the grounds as mentioned above, but feel that granting a license to the Village Superstore would lead to further crime and disorder in this area.

*Public Safety would be a major concern (which I would hope would be quite high on the council's agenda)

*Public nuisance would increase due to the constant consumption of alcohol, and let's not forget that there are many children in this community who could come to harm by the granting of this application.

*Additional waste would be created where not required, adding a further but minor environmental concern.

Enclosed are signatures of those residents in the area that also object to having 2 off-licences in the area and who feel that this would lead to an increase in the level of crime and disorder in the area.

I hope our concerns will be noted as you consider the application.
