DECISIONS:

1. APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE FOR Wharfedale
HARE & HOUNDS, 47 BRADFORD ROAD, MENSTON, ILKLEY

Resolved –

That having considered all valid representations made by the parties to the hearing, valid written representations received during the statutory period, the published statement of licensing policy and relevant statutory guidance; the panel grants the application subject to the following condition:-

That prior to any licensable activities taking place under the licence hereby approved the children's outside play area shall be moved from its current location to the area shown hatched black on the attached plan (entitled "Hare & Hounds, Menston") and that the said area shall at all times be fenced off from the remainder of the premises.

Reason: To limit noise and disturbance to local residents from patrons of the premises using the children's outside play area late at night – in accordance with the prevention of public nuisance licensing objective.
