
DECISION:

1. **APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE FOR THE BEST ONE XPRESS, 206-210 LEEDS ROAD, SHIPLEY** Windhill & Wrose

Resolved -

That having considered all valid representations made by parties to the hearing; valid representations made during the statutory period, the published statement of licensing policy and relevant statutory guidance, the Panel grants the application subject to the following conditions:

- (i) A CCTV system with internal and external coverage shall be installed at the premises and be of a standard acceptable to the Licensing Authority in consultation with West Yorkshire Police, be maintained in good working order and used at all times the premises remain open to the public for licensable activities. Any CCTV footage shall be made available to the Licensing Authority or a Responsible Authority on request. The CCTV installation shall be made available for inspection by West Yorkshire Police prior to the opening of the premises.
- (ii) An appropriate proof of age policy, incorporating the principles of the Think/Challenge 21 Campaign shall be implemented; incorporating measures to ensure that any patron wishing to purchase alcohol who may be reasonably appear to be under 21 years of age are asked to prove they are at least 18 years old by displaying evidence of their identity and age in the form of a valid UK passport or new style driving licence displaying their photograph.
- (iii) All staff employed in the premises must be adequately trained in their responsibility for enforcing the proof of age policy, all relevant conditions of licence and all relevant licensing laws.
- (iv) That the Licensee shall ensure that the external areas around the perimeter of the premises are kept clear of litter and refuse.
