2.4 Steps proposed by the applicant to address the Licensing Objectives

Provision of adequate lighting.
Communication links to other licensed premises.
Working closely to local PC Turnball or local PC Officer. Have links to local police office.
Use of social networking to keep community aware of any crime or disorder.

b) Public safety will be achieved by;

Seating arrangements.

c) Prevention of public nuisance will be achieved by;

Daily litter clearance.
Notices to ask patrons to leave quietly.

No use of external area 11pm.

The use of social networking site to promote good relations with public.

d) Protection of children from harm will be achieved by;

Requirements for children under 16 to be accompanied by adult. Notices stating above after 11pm.

e) General – all four licensing objectives

Keeping close links with local Police Authority and local Police Officer. Keeping premises clean and tidy and free from nuisance. Daily litter clearance. Polite notices to keep public aware and considerate to other people. Keeping close links with all our customers through social networking and local website.

2.5 Relevant Representations Received

Responsible Authority

Environmental Health – A representation has been received from the Environmental Health Officer who has concerns that the extended hours could result in adverse impacts on the neighbourhood, with patrons causing noise and disturbance due to the comings and goings at the premises late at night. In order to address the prevention of public nuisance objective, the officer had recommended that the business operates within the hours stated on the current planning consent which are as follows;

Sunday to Thursday:	08.00 to 23.30
Friday & Saturday:	08.00 to Midnight

A copy of the representation is attached at Appendix 2.

Individual, Body or Business

A letter of representation has been received from a local resident. The representation raises concerns about noise nuisance due to increased hours. Concern is also raised about litter problems and food being dropped or thrown on the road.

4. OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

Legal Appraisal

4.1 The Licensing Act 2003 requires the Council to carry out its various licensing functions so as to promote the following four licensing objectives:

- a) the prevention of crime and disorder
 - b) public safety
 - c) the prevention of public nuisance
 - d) the protection of children from harm
- 4.2 The Council must also have regard to the guidance issued by the Department of Culture Media and Sport under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003. Regard must also be taken of the Council's statement of Licensing Policy for the District.
- 4.3 Where it is decided it is necessary to depart from the statutory guidance or the Licensing Policy on the merits of a particular case; then special reasons justifying this must be given that can be sustained.
- 4.4 Only "relevant representations" by or expressly on behalf of a defined "interested party" or "responsible authority" can be taken into account. In order to be "relevant" a representation must fairly relate to achieving a licensing objective. If it does not, it must be discounted.
- 4.5 Any licensing conditions that Members may propose attaching must also relate to achieving one of the licensing objectives; be tailored to the actual premises and style of licensable activity; must be reasonably achievable by the applicant and in his/her control.

Statement of Policy Issues

- 4.6.1 The following parts of the Licensing Policy are of particular importance; Part 6 (prevention of public nuisance).
- 4.7 The Annexes to the Policy sets out various types of model condition that could be considered.

- 5.1 Members may:
- (a) Grant a premises licence as applied for subject to any mandatory conditions and the precautions specified in the operating schedule submitted.
 - (b) Grant a premises licence subject to such additional conditions relating to achievement of the licensing objectives as members think fit; or
 - (c) Refuse the application for a premises licence.
- 5.2 Should the applicant or any other party to the hearing feel aggrieved at any decision with regard to the licence or to any conditions or restrictions attached by Members they may appeal to the Magistrates Court.

Article 6 – A procedural right to a fair hearing. As refusal of the application is an option, adherence to the Panels' usual procedure of affording a hearing to the applicant is very important. The applicant should also be able to examine the requirements of the fire authority. If the decision is to refuse then reasons should be given.

RE: 'Tucos Hot food Takeaway', 54 Kirkkgate Silsden - Licence application for extension of hours for hot food take-away.

I am writing to confirm that I have some concerns regarding the above premises licence application to extend opening hours to Midnight on any day and 3am on Fridays and Saturdays.

In my opinion, this could result in adverse impacts on the neighbourhood as a result of the potentially extended hours of noise and disturbance relating to the comings and goings to the premises. I would therefore recommend the refusal of an extension to the licensed opening hours.

In addition I must point out that the current Planning consents for this undertaking stipulate that the business must not operate between the hours of 11.30 pm and 8 am on Sunday to Thursday and 12.00 pm and 8 am on Fridays and Saturdays.
