DECISIONS:

1. APPLICATION FOR A VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE <u>Baildon</u> FOR GHYLL BECK RESTAURANT, GHYLL BECK GOLF DRIVING RANGE, ESHOLT LANE, BAILDON

Decision -

That, having considered all valid representations made by the parties to the hearing; valid written representations received during the statutory period, the published statement of licensing policy and relevant statutory guidance; the panel grants (in part) the application subject to the following conditions:

(1) Hours of licensable activities restricted as follows:

Friday to Monday 0900 to 0200 Tuesday to Thursday 0900 to midnight

Reason: To prevent noise, disturbance and nuisance to residents in the vicinity

of the premises - prevention of public nuisance objectives.

(2) That no events catering solely for people under 21 years of age be permitted.

Reason: It is considered that the above condition is necessary to ensure that the

premises do not attract underage patrons and to limit disturbance to local residents from patrons using the premises - prevention of public

nuisance and protection of children from harm objectives.
