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A. PROCEDURAL ITEMS

1. **ALTERNATE MEMBERS** (Standing Order 34)

The City Solicitor will report the names of alternate Members who are attending the meeting in place of appointed Members.

2. **DISCLOSURES OF INTEREST**

(Members Code of Conduct - Part 4A of the Constitution)

To receive disclosures of personal and prejudicial interests from members and co-opted members on matters to be considered at the meeting. The disclosure must include the nature of the interest.

An interest must also be disclosed in the meeting when it only becomes apparent to the member during the meeting.

Notes:

- (1) Members may remain in the meeting and take part fully in discussion and voting unless the interest is prejudicial. A personal interest is prejudicial if a member of the public with knowledge of the relevant facts would reasonably regard it as so significant that it is likely to prejudice the Member's judgement of the public interest. The Member must withdraw from the meeting if the interest is prejudicial unless a dispensation has been obtained from the Standards Committee.
- (2) Members in arrears of Council Tax by more than two months must not vote in decisions on, or which might affect, budget calculations, and must disclose at the meeting that this restriction applies to them. A failure to comply with these requirements is a criminal offence under section 106 of the Local Government Finance Act 1992.
- (3) Officers must disclose interests in accordance with Council Standing Order 44.

B. BUSINESS ITEMS

5. PROPOSAL TO RELAX STREET TRADING RESTRICTIONS IN City THE CITY PARK AREA OF BRADFORD CITY CENTRE

At the meeting on 20 January 2012 Members considered a proposal to relax street trading restrictions in the City Park area of Bradford City Centre. It was resolved that the statutory consultation period and advertisement period be initiated and that draft guidance on the criteria for granting applications for consent to trade in the defined City Park area of the city be produced.

The formal objection period for that consultation has now ended and the Assistant Director, Environmental & Regulatory Services, will present a report (**Document "B"**) which advises that no representations have been received in response to the consultation and presents draft guidance on the criteria for granting applications for consent to trade.

Members are asked to consider whether to resolve to adopt the proposal to designate the 'City Park' area of Bradford City Centre as a consent area for the purposes of street trading or resolve not to designate the area referred to.

If Members resolve to designate the 'City Park' area of Bradford City Centre as a consent area for the purposes of street trading they are also requested to authorise the adoption of the draft 'City Park' Street Trading Policy attached at Appendix 2 to Document "B"(subject to any amendments or alterations they may wish to make) as a guide to decision making.
