The licensing officer in attendance summarised the background to the application which included details of the proposed Premises Licence and valid representations received as set out in the report.

The applicant's representative informed Members that the property had previously been a fish and chip shop and then a takeaway. The proposed restaurant was a new venture for the applicant, however, she had experience within the trade. Alterations would be made to the premises and the necessary planning consent had been granted. A representation had been received from a local resident, though the applicant's representative indicated that there were other shops and commercial premises in the vicinity. The restaurant would close at 23.30 hours and play background music for the enjoyment of the diners only. The amenity of local residents would be respected and the applicant's agent stated that he was confident that there would not be any noise or behaviour problems.
