## 1. Summary

### 1.1 The applicant

### 1.2 The Premises

Prince of Wales Inn, 242-248 Bowling Old Road, West Bowling, Bradford

### 1.4 Current Licence

The premises currently hold a Premises Licence with the following permitted hours;

#### Sale/supply of alcohol

Monday to Saturday:	10.00 to 23.00
Sunday/Good Friday:	Noon to 22.30
Christmas Day:	Noon to 15.00
Christmas Day:	19.00 to 22.30
New Years Eve:	10.00 hours until the start of permitted hours the following day

### 1.5 Variation Application

The variation application has been submitted to extend permitted hours for the sale of alcohol, include the provision of regulated entertainment (exhibition of films, indoor sporting events, live music, recorded music, anything of a similar description & provision of facilities for making music) and late night refreshment (from 23.00), remove Condition 3 from the Licence and include an outside area.

New Years Eve:	10.00 hours until the start of permitted hours the following day

#### Provision of regulated entertainment

Monday to Sunday:	12.00 to 23.00
Christmas Eve/Boxing Day:	12.00 to 00.30
New Years Eve:	12.00 hours until the start of permitted hours the following day

Premises opening hours & Provision of late night refreshment (from 23.00)

Monday to Sunday:	10.00 to 00.30
Christmas Eve/Boxing Day:	10.00 to 01.30
New Years Eve:	10.00 hours until the start of permitted hours the following day

**1.6 Steps proposed by the applicant to address the Licensing Objectives**

a) Prevention of crime and disorder will be achieved by;  
Zero tolerance on drugs, violence or any form of anti-social behaviour or disorder to the local community.  
To be a member of pubwatch.  
No open bottles/containers to leave the premises.  
Staff to be vigilant as customers depart the premises to ensure no problems occur.

b) Public Safety will be achieved by;

Health & safety at work/fire procedures posters.  
Accident book/first aid kit.  
Fire/workplace risk assessments.  
Fire alarm/smoke detectors/emergency lights. Fire extinguishers. All tested regularly.  
All areas to be cleared of bottles/glasses on a regular basis and all exits/entrances to be kept clear at all times in case of an emergency.

c) Prevention of public nuisance will be achieved by;

Noise levels will be checked on a regular basis to ensure no noise nuisance is caused to any neighbours.  
Notices requesting customers leave quietly and respectful to any neighbours.  
Staff vigilance at all times.

d) Protection of children from harm will be achieved by;

The premises to have house rules relating to children and shall be the responsibility of the DPS.  
Challenge 21 scheme to be in place.  
Only recognised proof of age cards accepting passport, Portman group, uk photo id driving licence.

e) General – all four licensing objectives

## 2. Relevant Representations Received

### 2.1 Interested Parties

Local residents – A petition has been received from local residents on the grounds of noise nuisance from regulated entertainment and noise and anti-social behaviour from patrons leaving the premises late at night. Concern is also raised about rubbish outside the premises.

Members will note that the addresses on the petition cover a very wide area, and may wish to consider the issue of vicinity in respect of the following streets;

Ryan Street/Parkside Road/Avenue Road/Silverdale Road/Springmill  
Street/Parsonage Road/New Cross Street/Birch Lane/Hastings  
Avenue/Donisthorpe Street.

The petition is attached at Appendix 3.

## 3. Legal Appraisal

3.1 The Licensing Act 2003 requires the Council to carry out its various licensing functions so as to promote the following four licensing objectives:

- a) The prevention of crime and disorder
- b) Public safety
- c) The prevention of public nuisance
- d) The protection of children from harm

3.2 The Council must also have regard to the guidance issued by the Department of Culture Media and Sport under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003. Regard must also be taken of the Council's statement of Licensing Policy for the District.

3.3 Where it is decided it is necessary to depart from the statutory guidance or the Licensing Policy on the merits of a particular case; then special reasons justifying this must be given that can be sustained.

3.4 Only "relevant representations" by or expressly on behalf of a defined "interested party" or "responsible authority" can be taken into account. In order to be "relevant" a representation must fairly relate to achieving a licensing objective. If it does not, it must be discounted.

3.5 Any licensing conditions that Members may propose attaching must also relate to achieving one of the licensing objectives; be tailored to the actual premises and style of licensable activity; must be reasonably achievable by the applicant and in his/her control.

#### 4. **Statement of Policy Issues**

- 4.1 The following parts of the Licensing Policy are of particular importance; Part 6 (prevention of Public Nuisance).
- 4.2 The Annexes to the Policy sets out various types of model condition that could be considered. Those in Annex A; Annex B; Annex D and Annex E may have conditions that are of particular relevance.

#### 5. **Legal Options**

- 5.1 Members may:
  - (a) Vary the premises licence as applied for subject to any mandatory conditions and the precautions specified in the operating schedule submitted.
  - (b) Vary the premises licence in whole or in part subject to such additional conditions relating to achievement of the licensing objectives as members think fit; or
  - (c) Refuse to vary the premises licence.
- 5.2 Should the applicant or any other party to the hearing feel aggrieved at any decision with regard to the licence or to any conditions or restrictions attached by Members they may appeal to the Magistrates Court.

#### 6. **Financial and resource appraisal**

- 6.1 There are no apparent finance or resource implications.

##### 7.1 **Equal Rights**

The following rights are applicable:

Article 1 First Protocol to the Convention – Right to peaceful enjoyment of possessions subject to the state's right to control the use of property in accordance with the general interest. The Council's powers set out in the recommendations fall within the states right. A fair balance must be struck between public safety and the applicant's rights.

Article 6 – A procedural right to a fair hearing. As refusal of the application is an option, adherence to the Panels' usual procedure of affording a hearing to the applicant is very important. The applicant should also be able to examine the requirements of the fire authority. If the decision is to refuse then reasons should be given.

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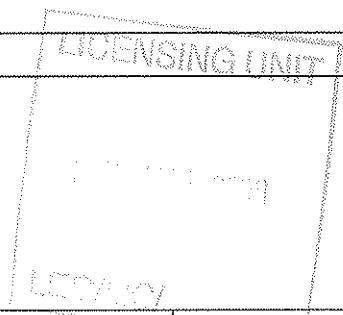

## **Annex 1 – Mandatory Conditions**

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence;-
  - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

### **Embedded Conditions**

3. None of the restrictions on permitted hours prohibit:
  - a. During the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
  - b. Consumption of the alcohol on the premises or the taking of the sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises;
  - c. The ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
  - d. The sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
  - e. The sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the supply or sale of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's Naval, Military or Air Forces;
  - f. The taking of alcohol from the premises by a person residing there; or
  - g. The supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to any private friends of a person residing there who are bona fide entertained by him at his own expense, or the consumption of alcohol by persons so supplied; or

The supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purposes of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, or the consumption of liquor so supplied, if the liquor is supplied at the expense of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises.

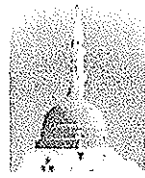

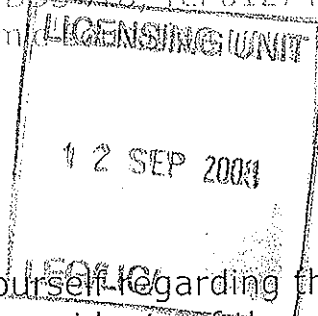
