DECISIONS:

1. TWO APPLICATIONS FOR A REVIEW OF THE PREMISES LICENCE FOR IDLE VILLAGE OFF-LICENCE, 10 BRADFORD ROAD, IDLE, BRADFORD Idle

Resolved –

That having considered all valid representations made by the parties to the hearing in relation to both reviews; the published statement of licensing policy and relevant statutory guidance; the Panel revokes the premises licence.

Reason: Having regard to the compelling evidence, presented by the West Yorkshire Police review applicant and the interested party applicant relating to persistent breaches of the licence, licensing laws and conditions (particularly those relating to the sale of alcohol to underage customers and the requirement to ensure an effective proof of age policy at all times, the requirement to make CCTV footage readily available to Responsible Authorities on request, the requirement to ensure adequate staff training on relevant licensing laws and the requirement that the Designated Premises Supervisor demonstrates adequate personal supervision of the premises to ensure compliance with the law at all times), the Panel considers revocation of the Licence is justified in order to address serious issues related to the Prevention of Crime and Disorder, Public Nuisance and the protection of Children from Harm objectives.
