1.4 Application

The application is for the grant of a Premises Licence. The operating schedule describes the following as the relevant licensable activities applied for:-

1.5 Steps proposed by the applicant to address the Licensing Objectives

a) Prevention of crime and disorder will be achieved by;

Drugs policies/notices.

b) Public Safety will be achieved by;

Provision of emergency lighting.

c) Prevention of public nuisance will be achieved by;

Keeping the music to a reasonable level.
Considerate loading/unloading arrangements

d) Protection of children from harm will be achieved by;

Restricting access to adult entertainment, eg lap dancing, age restricted films etc
Proof of age cards.
Prevention of access to gaming machines.

e) General – all four licensing objectives

Providing registered door supervisors.
Staff training on licensing issues.

2. Relevant Representations Received

2.1 Interested Parties

Local Business – 1 letter of representation has been received, on the grounds of anticipated anti-social behaviour and noise and disturbance from patrons leaving the premises late at night.

The letter is attached at Appendix 2.

3. Legal Appraisal

3.1 The Licensing Act 2003 requires the Council to carry out its various licensing functions so as to promote the following four licensing objectives:

- a) the prevention of crime and disorder
- b) public safety
- c) the prevention of public nuisance
- d) the protection of children from harm

3.2 The Council must also have regard to the guidance issued by the Department of Culture Media and Sport under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003. Regard must also be taken of the Council's statement of Licensing Policy for the District.

3.3 Where it is decided it is necessary to depart from the statutory guidance or the Licensing Policy on the merits of a particular case; then special reasons justifying this must be given that can be sustained.

3.4 Only "relevant representations" by or expressly on behalf of a defined "interested party" or "responsible authority" can be taken into account. In order to be "relevant" a representation must fairly relate to achieving a licensing objective. If it does not, it must be discounted.

3.5 Any licensing conditions that Members may propose attaching must also relate to achieving one of the licensing objectives; be tailored to the actual premises and

style of licensable activity; must be reasonably achievable by the applicant and in his/her control.

4. Statement of Policy Issues

- 4.1 The following part of the Licensing Policy is of particular importance; Part 4 (prevention of crime and disorder).
- 4.2 The Annexes to the Policy sets out various types of model condition that could be considered.

5. Legal Options

- 5.1 Members may:
 - (a) Grant a premises licence as applied for subject to any mandatory conditions and the precautions specified in the operating schedule submitted.
 - (b) Grant a premises licence subject to such additional conditions relating to achievement of the licensing objectives as members think fit; or
 - (c) Refuse the application for a premises licence. (this will effectively mean that the premises could not open unless by authority of a temporary event notice without breaching the licensing laws).
- 5.2 Should the applicant or any other party to the hearing feel aggrieved at any decision with regard to the licence or to any conditions or restrictions attached by Members they may appeal to the Magistrates Court.

6. Financial and resource appraisal

- 6.1 There are no apparent finance or resource implications.

7. Other implications

7.1 Equal Rights

There are no apparent equal rights implications.

7.3 Community safety implications

There are no apparent community safety implications.

7.4 Human Rights Act

The following rights are applicable:

Article 1 First Protocol to the Convention – Right to peaceful enjoyment of possessions subject to the state's right to control the use of property in accordance with the general interest. The Council's powers set out in the recommendations fall within the states right. A fair balance must be struck between public safety and the applicant's rights.

Article 6 – A procedural right to a fair hearing. As refusal of the application is an option, adherence to the Panels' usual procedure of affording a hearing to the applicant is very important. The applicant should also be able to examine the requirements of the fire authority. If the decision is to refuse then reasons should be given.

I would like to raise an objection to the proposed re-opening of the ex Transport Club, Sunbridge Road, Bradford, as a new venue.

I understand that there is a request for these premises to be licensed until 5am, to which I most strongly object.

Surely there is enough recent adverse publicity regarding the problems which we are already experiencing in the centre of the city due to alcohol related violence and disturbance.

I draw your attention to the article printed in the Telegraph and Argus, on Tuesday 28th July 2009, page 10, which I suggest you read without delay.

Headline – Early hours fights caught on CCTV

Within this article, it clearly states that the majority of the problems occur AFTER 2am and in the latest incident, Saturday 25th July 2009, it was 5.34am. Another incident, which took place on Saturday 3rd May, 2009, was recorded at 5.35am.

Although the problems surrounding these incidents have taken place on Ivegate, in Bradford, it is only a matter of 200 yards away from the proposed, new venue in question, located on Sunbridge Road.

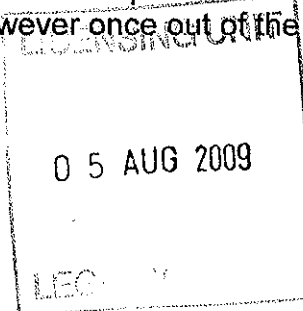
Surely by granting a license until 5am on these premises, it will only cause more alcohol fuelled disturbances, which in turn could lead to more violence in the vicinity, especially at closing time, which could be as late as 5.30am to 6am.

There is already another venue in close proximity, The Boiler House, Godwin Street, which has a license until 6am, why is there a need for a late license to be granted to another premises within 200 yards.

It does not make sense.

Why add fuel to the already raging fire.

It is the responsibility of licensees to police their own premises and take care of their customers whilst on their premises, however once out of the premises and on the street, who is responsible?



It is very much down to the police and the emergency services to deal with and the problems caused by alcohol related disturbances and violence, therefore granting this late license may only create more problems.

One of my major concerns is that if this late license is granted, what is to stop the customers of the new venue from spilling out onto Sunbridge Road in the early hours of the morning and smashing up the surrounding area including my premises, which is only a matter of 75 yards away. All extremely worrying.

As a responsible licensee, I am also aware that it is not necessarily the alcohol which has been bought and consumed on licensed premises that causes this drunken behaviour, but could feasibly and has usually been purchased from the supermarket and consumed prior to the customer entering the premises.

Although I cannot stop this from happening, I add it to my concerns.

My concerns and my objections are genuine and I sincerely hope that you will take this objection seriously and decline the late licence.
