**RECORD OF A HEARING FOR A PREMISES LICENCE FOR DICK LANE,
146 – 148 DICK LANE, BRADFORD**

Representations:

The Licensing Officer in attendance summarised the background to the application and valid representations as set out in Document "N".

She advised the Panel that West Yorkshire Police had requested that three conditions be attached to the licence, if granted. The applicant had not been willing to accept the third of those conditions until very recently and had only advised on 24 March 2010 that she now agreed to all three conditions.

The Chair sought confirmation that no other representations had been made and was advised that none had.

Decision -

That, having considered all valid representations made by parties to the hearing; valid representations made during the statutory period; the published statement of licensing policy and relevant statutory guidance, the Panel grants the application subject to the three conditions set out below:

- (i) A CCTV system shall be installed at the premises and be of a standard acceptable to the Licensing Authority and West Yorkshire Police, be maintained in good working order and used at all times the premises remain open to the public for licensable activities. Any CCTV footage shall be made available to the Licensing Authority or a Responsible Authority on request. The CCTV installation shall be viewed by West Yorkshire Police prior to the opening of the premises.**
- (ii) A personal licence holder shall be present on the premises between 19.00 and 23.00 hours when licensable activities are taking place.**
- (iii) A Challenge 21 policy shall be implemented.**

Reason: It is considered that the above conditions are necessary in order to ensure proper supervision of the premises and to ensure that there is an adequate system in place to prevent underage youths and children gaining access to alcohol. Prevention of crime and disorder and prevention of harm to children objectives.
