1. Summary

1.1 The applicant

Slackside Working Mens Club. A copy of the application is included at Appendix 1.

1.2 The Premises

Slackside WMC, 98 Beacon Road, Bradford.

The premise already has a Club Premises Certificate in force, but wishes to allow unrestricted access to non-members.

A copy of the Club Premises Certificate is attached at Appendix 2.

1.3 **Designated Premises Supervisor**

The named DPS has confirmed in writing that he has now withdrawn consent.

1.4 **Application**

The application is for the grant of a Premises Licence. The operating schedule describes the following as the relevant licensable activities applied for:-

- Sale/supply of alcohol
- Provision of regulated entertainment
- Provision of late night refreshment

Hours of licensable activities:

<u>Sale of alcohol, provision of regulated entertainment & provision of late night</u> refreshment (from 23.00)

Monday to Sunday: 08.00 to 02.00

Hours the premises proposed to be open:

Monday to Sunday: 07.00 to 03.00

1.5 Steps proposed by the applicant to address the Licensing Objectives

a) Prevention of crime and disorder will be achieved by;

Club rules covering the conduct of Members and their guests and general public within and adjacent to the Club premises. Misconduct is reported to the committee to consider action under Club rules. One hour wind down time.

b) Public Safety will be achieved by;

The Club complies with Health & Safety and Fire Regulations. Preventative and control measures are in place to ensure the safety of members, the public and employees. The Club complies with advised capacity limits. Emergency exits are sign posted.

c) Prevention of public nuisance will be achieved by;

Signage is displayed near exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents by leaving quietly. When live or recorded music is played all reasonable steps are taken to avoid disturbance to neighbouring properties.

d) Protection of children from harm will be achieved by;

No person under the age of 18 is allowed on the premises unless accompanied by parent or guardian. Signage prohibiting children from direct bar area.

e) General – all four licensing objectives

In house training given to staff relevant to their duties

2. Relevant Representations Received

2.1 Responsible Authorities

West Yorkshire Police - In order to address the prevention of crime and disorder objective, the Police have requested that the following conditions are placed on the Licence:

- 1. A Personal Licence holder shall be present on the premises every Friday and Saturday from 20.30 hours until licensable activities cease.
- 2. Bradford South Police Licensing Department shall be notified seven days in advance of any external bookings or large events which are to take place, which will cause the Club to have an increase in customers and cause them to remain open until 01.00 am.

The applicant has agreed to the conditions being placed on the Licence.

2.2 Interested Parties

<u>Local Residents</u> – A petition and a letter of representation have been received from local residents, on the grounds of anticipated noise and disturbance and anti-social behaviour by patrons congregating outside the premises to consume drinks and smoke and also leaving the premises late at night. Concern is also raised about the noise from the bottle bank being filled in the early hours of the morning and broken bottles and glass being left in the road and thrown in gardens.

The letter and petition are attached at Appendix 3.

3. Legal Appraisal

- 3.1 The Licensing Act 2003 requires the Council to carry out its various licensing functions so as to promote the following four licensing objectives:
 - a) the prevention of crime and disorder
 - b) public safety
 - c) the prevention of public nuisance
 - d) the protection of children from harm
- 3.2 The Council must also have regard to the guidance issued by the Department of Culture Media and Sport under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003. Regard must also be taken of the Council's statement of Licensing Policy for the District.
- 3.3 Where it is decided it is necessary to depart from the statutory guidance or the Licensing Policy on the merits of a particular case; then special reasons justifying this must be given that can be sustained.
- 3.4 Only "relevant representations" by or expressly on behalf of a defined "interested party" or "responsible authority" can be taken into account. In order to be "relevant" a representation must fairly relate to achieving a licensing objective. If it does not, it must be discounted.
- 3.5 Any licensing conditions that Members may propose attaching must also relate to achieving one of the licensing objectives; be tailored to the actual premises and style of licensable activity; must be reasonably achievable by the applicant and in his/her control.

4. Statement of Policy Issues

- 4.1 The following part of the Licensing Policy is of particular importance; Part 4 (prevention of Crime and Disorder) and Part 6 (prevention of Public Nuisance).
- 4.2 The Annexes to the Policy sets out various types of model condition that could be considered.

5. Legal Options

- 5.1 Members may:
 - (a) Grant a premises licence as applied for subject to any mandatory conditions and the precautions specified in the operating schedule submitted.
 - (b) Grant a premises licence subject to such additional conditions relating to achievement of the licensing objectives as members think fit; or
 - (c) Refuse the application for a premises licence. (this will effectively mean that the premises could not open unless by authority of a temporary event notice without breaching the licensing laws).
- 5.2 Should the applicant or any other party to the hearing feel aggrieved at any decision with regard to the licence or to any conditions or restrictions attached by Members they may appeal to the Magistrates Court.

6. Financial and resource appraisal

6.1 There are no apparent finance or resource implications.

7. Other implications

7.1 Equal Rights

There are no apparent equal rights implications.

7.2 Community safety implications

There are no apparent community safety implications.

7.3 Human Rights Act

The following rights are applicable:

Article 1 First Protocol to the Convention – Right to peaceful enjoyment of possessions subject to the state's right to control the use of property in accordance with the general interest. The Council's powers set out in the recommendations fall within the states right. A fair balance must be struck between public safety and the applicant's rights.

Article 6 – A procedural right to a fair hearing. As refusal of the application is an option, adherence to the Panels' usual procedure of affording a hearing to the applicant is very important. The applicant should also be able to examine the requirements of the fire authority. If the decision is to refuse then reasons should be given.



GROUND FLOOR



We live opposite the above mentioned club and do not agree with the opening hours to be extended in any such way!

Why do they need a license from 08.00hrs upto 02.00hrs everyday?

Why do they need a license for late night refreshment from 23.00hrs until 02.00hrs?

These hours are nightclub hours! not normal working mens club hours.

We most strongly oppose anymore opening hours, the licensee are unable to control the rabble they sell alcohol to as it is, you should try living nearby, my neighbours have already complained also, as well as phoning the police on numerous occasions, as we have.

We are totally fed up with the constant noise, swearing and foul language, we are not prudes but sometimes you start to think do they not know any words which are not of

the vernacular!

But don't let us forget the fighting, in July and August every party they catered for resulted in serious fights, really nasty ones where one girl was run over with the clubs wheelie bin, they ran the bin into passing cars who drove really slowly through the riot but obviously were too scared to stop. The police were called again as on previous occasions and arrests were made, two cars and the police van arrived to sort out the debacle!

Virtually every private party they host ends in warfare fuelled by drink, they wee up against the bakers door(next door to the club steps), we've moved our van from Beacon Road and now park on Thorncroft Road out of harms way as wing mirrors and lights have been broken, along with broken bottles in our garden and broken glass in the street, at this point i have to say the pub slightly further down the road is no problem at all. No fights that i know of, no offensive language and not the constant noise of the club as he has a lovely smoking area at the rear of his premises!

So smoking facilities, do any exist for the Slackside club?

I don't think so!

Why not, they have a rather large car park at the rear why can't they make some kind of language/smoke proof shelter?

Are they allowed to drink on the street? because every party they host including the ones held last in October all drink on the steps and in the alleyway and forecourt!

Is this allowed? is it legal or should all drink be consumed inside?

The regulated entertainment license, is this for extra loud groups to shatter our peace or just to hold longer parties where people get more drunk, the club makes a profit but no one else in the street can sleep?

The club licenses also fill the bottle bank up in the early hours of the morning sometimes just to really end a perfect night!
