

## Decision of the Bradford Licensing Panel held on Wednesday 13 April 2011

### DECISION:

1. **APPLICATION FOR A REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE** Toller  
**FOR GIRLINGTON MINI MARKET, 81 GIRLINGTON ROAD, BRADFORD**

Resolved –

That having considered all valid representations made by the parties to the hearing; valid written representations received during the statutory period, the published statement of licensing policy and relevant statutory guidance; the Panel revokes the premises licence.

**Reason:** Having regard to the compelling evidence, presented by the review applicant West Yorkshire Trading Standards relating to the serious and persistent breaches of the licence conditions (particularly those relating to the requirement of a proof of age policy; the requirement to make CCTV footage readily available to Responsible Authorities on request; and the requirement to ensure adequate staff training on relevant licensing laws); the serious and persistent breach of licensing laws in relation to the sale of alcohol to children; and the obstructive and aggressive behaviour to a police officer in uniform who was investigating alleged breaches of licensing laws and conditions, the Panel considers revocation of the Licence is justified in order to address serious concerns related to licensing activities carried out at these premises undermining the Prevention of Crime and Disorder and Prevention of Children from Harm objectives.
