The application is for the variation of a premises licence to extend permitted hours for the sale of alcohol.

Store fitted with a burglar alarm.

b) Public Safety will be achieved by;

To meet the requirements of the Fire Safety Order 2005.

c) Prevention of public nuisance will be achieved by;

No deliveries to take place between the hours of 23.00 and 06.00 the following day.

d) Protection of children from harm will be achieved by;

All staff are trained in relation to underage related sales of alcohol, proof of age scheme in place.

'Challenge 25' scheme in place and notices of this prominently displayed within the store.

Electric till prompt when alcohol is scanned to remind staff to check the age of the purchaser.

'Age Refusals Register', refusals book to be kept to record where sales of alcohol are challenged or refused.

e) General – all four licensing objectives

A closed circuit TV monitoring system to be installed and maintained, images recorded and retained for at least 21 days and to be handed to police/local authority on request.

Legal Appraisal

- **4.1** The Licensing Act 2003 requires the Council to carry out its various licensing functions so as to promote the following four licensing objectives:
 - a) The prevention of crime and disorder
 - b) Public safety
 - c) The prevention of public nuisance
 - d) The protection of children from harm

- 4.2 The Council must also have regard to the guidance issued by the Department of Culture Media and Sport under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003. Regard must also be taken of the Council's statement of Licensing Policy for the District.
- 4.3 Where it is decided it is necessary to depart from the statutory guidance or the Licensing Policy on the merits of a particular case; then special reasons justifying this must be given that can be sustained.
- 4.4 Only "relevant representations" by or expressly on behalf of a defined "interested party" or "responsible authority" can be taken into account. In order to be "relevant" a representation must fairly relate to achieving a licensing objective. If it does not, it must be discounted.
- 4.5 Any licensing conditions that Members may propose attaching must also relate to achieving one of the licensing objectives; be tailored to the actual premises and style of licensable activity; must be reasonably achievable by the applicant and in his/her control.

Statement of Policy Issues

- 4.6 The following parts of the Licensing Policy are of particular importance; Part 4 (prevention of Crime and Disorder, Part 6 (prevention of Public Nuisance).
- **4.7** The Annexes to the Policy sets out various types of model condition that could be considered.

5. OPTIONS

- **5.1** Members may:
 - (a) Vary the premises licence as applied for subject to any mandatory conditions and the precautions specified in the operating schedule submitted.
 - (b) Vary the premises licence in whole or in part subject to such additional conditions relating to achievement of the licensing objectives as members think fit; or
 - (c) Refuse to vary the premises licence.
- 5.2 Should the applicant or any other party to the hearing feel aggrieved at any decision with regard to the licence or to any conditions or restrictions attached by Members they may appeal to the Magistrates Court.
