## 1. SUMMARY

The application is for the grant of a Premises Licence for the sale of alcohol and provision of regulated entertainment and late night refreshment.

## 2. BACKGROUND

## 2.1 The applicants

East Bowling Unity Club. A copy of the application is included at Appendix 1.

## 2.2 The Premises

East Bowling Unity Club, Leicester Street, East Bowling, Bradford.

The premise already has a Club Premises Certificate in force, but wishes to allow unrestricted access to non-members.

A copy of the Club Premises Certificate is attached at Appendix 2.

## 2.4 Application

The application is for the grant of a Premises Licence. The operating schedule describes the following as the relevant licensable activities applied for:-

- Sale of alcohol for consumption on or off the premises
- Provision of Regulated Entertainment
- Provision of Late Night Refreshment (from 23.00 hours)

## 2.5 Steps proposed by the applicant to address the Licensing Objectives

a) Prevention of crime and disorder will be achieved by;

CCTV cameras in operation. Local partnership with police. Working with neighbourhood watch. Personal Licence Holder on premises.

b) Public safety will be achieved by;

CCTV in operation. Outside lighting. Staff training. Fire Exits marked. Fire Escapes marked.

c) Prevention of public nuisance will be achieved by;

Windows kept shut during live music. Music volume kept to a reasonable level. Litter cleared each day. Music restricted to 11.45 pm. Notices posted in Club asking members to leave Club quietly.

d) Protection of children from harm will be achieved by;

Restricting access to children no later than 7.00 pm, except on Christmas Day Night, unless they are attending a private party in the function room and accompanied by an adult at all times.

Proof of age required before buying drinks.

All children must be accompanied by an adult.

The Club operates a challenge 21 policy, if any guest/members look under 21 they will be asked for proof of age before being served.

No gaming machines are in place in the function room, keeping children from harm in that respect.

e) General - all four licensing objectives

None.

## 2.6 Relevant Representations Received

## Individual, Body or Business

2 letters of representation and 77 pro forma letters have been received from individuals, on the grounds of noise and disturbance and anti-social behaviour from patrons using the outdoor areas and leaving the premises late at night and noise

nuisance from regulated entertainment held at the premises. The residents also have concerns about litter problems.

The representations are attached at Appendix 3.

## Legal Appraisal

- 4.1 The Licensing Act 2003 requires the Council to carry out its various licensing functions so as to promote the following four licensing objectives:
  - a) the prevention of crime and disorder
  - b) public safety
  - c) the prevention of public nuisance
  - d) the protection of children from harm
- 4.2 The Council must also have regard to the guidance issued by the Department of Culture Media and Sport under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003. Regard must also be taken of the Council's statement of Licensing Policy for the District.
- 4.3 Where it is decided it is necessary to depart from the statutory guidance or the Licensing Policy on the merits of a particular case; then special reasons justifying this must be given that can be sustained.
- 4.4 Only "relevant representations" by or expressly on behalf of a defined "interested party" or "responsible authority" can be taken into account. In order to be "relevant" a representation must fairly relate to achieving a licensing objective. If it does not, it must be discounted.
- 4.5 Any licensing conditions that Members may propose attaching must also relate to achieving one of the licensing objectives; be tailored to the actual premises and style of licensable activity; must be reasonably achievable by the applicant and in his/her control.

## **Statement of Policy Issues**

- 4.6 The following parts of the Licensing Policy are of particular importance; Part 4 (prevention of crime and disorder) and Part 6 (prevention of public nuisance).
- 4.7 The Annexes to the Policy sets out various types of model condition that could be considered.

## 5. OPTIONS

- 5.1 Members may:
  - (a) Grant a premises licence as applied for subject to any mandatory conditions and the precautions specified in the operating schedule submitted.
  - (b) Grant a premises licence subject to such additional conditions relating to achievement of the licensing objectives as members think fit; or
  - (c) Refuse the application for a premises licence.
- 5.2 Should the applicant or any other party to the hearing feel aggrieved at any decision with regard to the licence or to any conditions or restrictions attached by Members they may appeal to the Magistrates Court.

The applicant should also be able to examine the requirements of the fire authority. If the decision is to refuse then reasons should be given.



EBUC/LSCC Leicester Street, East Bowling, BD4 7JS. Continues to its unofficial 1/2 hour extension to its Alcohol/Entertainment License on weekend nights. That is this Club is breaking its Licensing hours of operation by at lease an half an hour. Also in the past they have broken them by 2 to 3 hours.

The Club rents out the Presidents Suit more than once a month, and does NOT provide any security, in terms of a doorman. Even on the main Club enterance, the door mans hours have been reduced, so much, that practically anybody can walk in and get served, especially in the concert room. These days the door man is not always being used, and because the club is desperate for business, anyone doe get served.

The illegal sourcing of alcoholic products has to be a major concern to somebody, doe it not ? When a Bar server, dis-appears to the other side of the central bar to get shorts of distilled alcohol, and fill up glasses of wine, to serve customers, one has to wonder where it came from, (That is, what bottle or container it was poured from.) Especially when the bottles are clearly visible on each side of the bar.

## How long is this going to be allowed to continue ??

The loud ground thumping is annoying, from the artistist speakers base units. The noisy drunks leaving the club well after midnight and almost 1 am on a Sunday. Tonight, shortly after midnught abusive language was shouted at our house as drunk customers leaving the club passed by.
