DECISIONS:

1. APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE FOR B & M STORES, KINGS ROAD, BRADFORD

Bolton & Undercliffe

Decision -

That, having considered all valid representations made by the parties to the hearing; valid written representations received during the statutory period, the published statement of licensing policy and relevant statutory guidance; the panel grants the application subject to the following condition:

(1) That an appropriate proof of age policy, incorporating measures to ensure that any patron wishing to purchase alcohol who may reasonably appear to be under 25 years of age are asked to prove they are at least 18 years old by displaying evidence of their identity and age in the form of a valid UK passport or new style driving licence displaying their photograph or PASS identification.

Reason:

It is considered that the above condition is necessary to ensure the proper management and monitoring of the premises in order to ensure alcohol is not purchased or supplied to those underage – protection of children from harm and prevention of crime and disorder licensing objectives.
