55. WOODHEAD ROAD, BRADFORD - OBJECTION TO A PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

The report of the Strategic Director, Place (**Document “AB”**) considered an objection to a recently advertised Traffic Regulation Order for proposed waiting restrictions on Woodhead Road and Summerville Road, Bradford.

The Committee highlighted importance of the Highways and Planning Section to work closely with one another in order to accelerate and resolve the issues of parking in the Bradford West area.

Resolved –

That the objection be overruled and the pedestrian refuge on Woodhead Road be constructed and the proposed Traffic Regulation Order at the junction of Woodhead Road and Summerville Road be sealed and implemented as advertised.

56. HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE NON-CLASSIFIED ROADS AND SURFACE DRESSING ALLOCATION FOR BRADFORD WEST - 2017/18
