3. APPLICATION FOR A REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE FOR MARS A DAY, 274 LUMB LANE, BRADFORD,

Resolved -

That having considered all valid representations made by the parties to the hearing; valid written representations received during the statutory period, the published statement of licensing policy and relevant statutory guidance; the panel determines that the premises licence be revoked.

Reason: That, in light of the evidence presented by West Yorkshire

Trading Standards Service and West Yorkshire Police, the Panel felt that revocation was the only appropriate and proportionate approach to address all four of the licensing

objectives.
