2. DISCLOSURES OF INTEREST

(Members Code of Conduct - Part 4A of the Constitution)

To receive disclosures of interests from Members and co-opted members on matters to be considered at the meeting. The disclosure must include the nature of the interest.

An interest must also be disclosed in the meeting when it becomes apparent to the Member during the meeting.

Notes:

- (1) *Members may remain in the meeting and take part fully in discussion and voting unless the interest is a disclosable pecuniary interest or an interest which the Member feels would call into question their compliance with the wider principles set out in the Code of Conduct. Disclosable pecuniary interests relate to the Member concerned or their spouse/partner.*

1. SUMMARY

- The street name 'Herbert Street' to be renamed as 'Mohammed Ali Gardens'.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Currently there are no properties addressed on Herbert Street. The owner of 56 Park Lane, will retain this address for residential use and will be requiring some new commercial addresses for some units on 'Herbert Street'.
- 2.2 The applicant Balaal Hussain Khan has requested the street name to be changed to 'Mohammed Ali Gardens'.
- 2.3 The following statement has been provided in support of a decision to approve the allocation of 'Mohammed Ali Gardens' as a new name for the 'Herbert Street'.

'Herbert Street' to 'Mohammed Ali Gardens'

Why Mohammed Ali Gardens? This name will represent hope, vision and determination. It has been chosen paying homage to my grandparents, Mohammed Ali Jinnah; the founder of Pakistan and Mohammed Ali; the boxer. All who have been role models to myself and the wider local community.

Grandparents

My grandparents 'Mohammed' Ayub and 'Ali' Begum migrated to Bradford in 1963, leaving everything behind as every other South Asian during that era. My grandfather moved to BD5 and worked in textile mills within the area making the area into his home and home for his future generations. My grandmother joined him with my father and his siblings in 1975 when my father was 15. The name of the street will be a combination of my grandparents first names. The name will pay respect to the sacrifices they made and the other migrants from Pakistan made to make this area into their home.

Mohammed Ali Jinnah

Mohammed Ali Jinnah, the founder of Pakistan was an idol to myself, a barrister who studied law in London and dedicated his life to fighting for justice, equality and freedom. Known as 'Quaid-I Azam' translated to 'Great Leader'. It is due to my aspirations of Mohammed Ali Jinnah that I have pursued a career in Law and have decided to give back to my local community by investing into the local area of BD5 bringing back buildings into use and employing people from within the area providing free access to justice to all.

Mohammed Ali - Professional Boxer

Mohammad Ali- the professional boxer, activist, entertainer, poet, and philanthropist. Nicknamed 'The Greatest', regarded as one of the most significant and celebrated sporting figures of the 20th century, and the best heavyweight boxer and greatest athlete of the century. By naming the street to Mohammed Ali Gardens it will pay homage to these great personalities and represent the hardships of the last century to the future generations who will see it as hope. With vision, hard work and determination anything is possible.

As the naming of a new street after any individual is a sensitive matter, to be given very serious consideration, and is usually only approved in exceptional circumstances, it is sensible to provide an alternative suggestion in the event that the Committee does not approve this proposal. In this particular case, should the Committee not be minded to approve this proposal;

The name 'Shiraz Street' will be the allocated street name following consultation with the Ward Councillors as part of the current Policy and Protocol.


