Decision

3. APPLICATION FOR A REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE FOR TREEHOUSE BAR AND KITCHEN, 3 FALLWOOD STREET, OFF OAK STREET, HAWORTH, BD22 8NP

Resolved -

That having considered the evidence contained in the report of the Interim Assistant Director, Waste, Fleet and Transport Services (Document 'K'); all valid representations made by the parties to the hearing; valid written representations received during the statutory period; the published statement of licensing policy and relevant statutory guidance, the Panel was minded to impose the following conditions:-

- (1) the permitted hours for the sale of alcohol for consumption on and off the premises, the provision of regulated entertainment and the provision of late night refreshments shall be restricted to Friday and Saturday 10.00 to 23.00;
- (2) all outward opening exit doors and all windows are to be kept closed when amplified regulated entertainment is taking place except for access and egress;
- (3) noise from the provision of regulated entertainment shall be inaudible at the nearest noise sensitive premises; and
- (4) the external areas should be cleared of customers no later than 22:00.

Reason – it is considered the above conditions are necessary to promote the prevention of Public Nuisance and Crime and Disorder licensing objectives.
