Decision

3. APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE FOR HOWDY, 375-377 LEEDS ROAD, BRADFORD, BD3 9LY

Resolved –

That having considered the evidence contained in the report of the Interim Assistant Director, Waste, Fleet and Transport Services (Document 'L'); valid written representations received during the statutory period; the published statement of licensing policy and relevant statutory guidance; the Panel GRANTS the application subject to the following conditions:

- (1) That staff shall be trained in efficient methods for ensuring customers leave the premises in a quiet and orderly fashion;
- (2) That notices shall be displayed in prominent positions near exits reminding patrons to leave in a quiet and orderly manner; and
- (3) That the premises licence holder shall ensure that the external areas of the premises are kept clear of litter and refuse.

Reason – it is considered the above conditions are necessary to promote the prevention of Public Nuisance and Crime and Disorder licensing objectives.
