Application

The Interim Assistant Director Waste, Fleet and Transport Services presented a report (Document "N") which asked the Panel to consider a personal licence following a conviction of a relevant offence by the holder of that licence.

The Licensing Officer reported that the Licensing Authority had been notified by West Yorkshire Police that the personal licence holder had been convicted of a relevant offence as defined in Schedule 4 of the Licensing Act. It was confirmed that the licence holder did not inform the Council, as Licensing Authority, of the offence.

The report outlined the rationale for the request and the options available to the Panel. A copy of the Personal Licence was appended to the report together with a list of relevant offences; offence details and Court correspondence and a notice to the Personal Licence holder.

Members questioned if the licence holder was still working at licensed premises and it was confirmed that this was the case.

The Council's Licensing Officer explained that no response had been made to telephone calls, emails or the notice to the Personal Licence holder. It was agreed that he had been given sufficient opportunity to provide representations.

Decision

That having considered the evidence contained in the report of the Interim Assistant Director, Waste, Fleet and Transport Services (Document 'N'), the published statement of licensing policy and relevant guidance and to support Part 4 of the licensing policy objectives (prevention of crime and disorder), the panel revoke the personal licence held by Mr B Singh.
