Decisions

3. **APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE AT BOLTON ROAD
CONVENIENCE STORE, UNIT 4, 1107 BOLTON ROAD, BRADFORD, BD2 4ST**

Decision –

That having considered all valid representations made by the parties to the hearing; valid written representations received during the statutory period, the published statement of licensing policy and relevant statutory guidance; the panel grants the application subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the Licensee shall ensure that premises staff monitor, on a frequent basis, noise emanating from the premises to ensure that neighbouring residents are not disturbed.**
- 2. That the Licensee shall ensure that the external areas around the perimeter of the premises are kept clear of litter and refuse.**
- 3. That prominent signs be displayed at all public exits to the premises requesting patrons to be quiet on leaving and entering.**

Reason – it is considered that the above conditions are necessary to minimise noise disturbance to nearby residents – prevention of public nuisance objective and to deter and ameliorate any anti-social behaviour – prevention of public nuisance objective.
