A. PROCEDURAL ITEMS

1. ALTERNATE MEMBERS (Standing Order 34)

The Director of Legal and Governance will report the names of alternate Members who are attending the meeting in place of appointed Members.

2. DISCLOSURES OF INTEREST

(Members Code of Conduct – Part 4A of the Constitution)

To receive disclosures of interests from members and co-opted members on matters to be considered at the meeting. The disclosure must include the nature of the interest.

An interest must also be disclosed in the meeting when it becomes apparent to the member during the meeting.

Notes:

- (1) *Members must consider their interests, and act according to the following:*

Type of Interest	You must:
<i>Disclosable Pecuniary Interests</i>	<i>Disclose the interest; not participate in the discussion or vote; and leave the meeting <u>unless</u> you have a dispensation.</i>
<i>Other Registrable Interests (Directly Related)</i> OR <i>Non-Registrable Interests (Directly Related)</i>	<i>Disclose the interest; speak on the item <u>only</u> if the public are also allowed to speak but otherwise not participate in the discussion or vote; and leave the meeting <u>unless</u> you have a dispensation.</i>
<i>Other Registrable Interests (Affects)</i> OR <i>Non-Registrable Interests (Affects)</i>	<i>Disclose the interest; remain in the meeting, participate and vote <u>unless</u> the matter affects the financial interest or well-being (a) to a greater extent than it affects the financial interests of a majority of inhabitants of the affected ward, and (b) a reasonable member of the public knowing all the facts would believe that it would affect your view of the wider</i>

*public interest;
in which case speak on the item only if
the public are also allowed to speak
but otherwise not do not participate in
the discussion or vote; and leave the
meeting unless you have a
dispensation.*

- (2) *Disclosable pecuniary interests relate to the Member concerned or their spouse/partner.*
- (3) *Members in arrears of Council Tax by more than two months must not vote in decisions on, or which might affect, budget calculations, and must disclose at the meeting that this restriction applies to them. A failure to comply with these requirements is a criminal offence under section 106 of the Local Government Finance Act 1992.*
- (4) *Officers must disclose interests in accordance with Council Standing Order 44.*

6. DELEGATION SCHEME FOR TRANSPORTATION AND HIGHWAYS DECISIONS 2023 1 - 52

The Strategic Director of Place will submit a report (**Document “E”**) which seeks the committee’s approval to replacing the Council’s current Transportation and Highways Scheme of Delegation (2017) with an up-to-date scheme for regulation of officer decision-making.

Recommended –

- (1) That the Regulatory and Appeals Committee approves the adoption of the replacement Scheme of Delegation for Highways and Transportation matters as set out in Appendix B to Document “E” in substitution for the current Scheme of Delegation for Highways and Transportation matters as set out in Appendix A to Document “E” in so far as the powers listed in the revised Scheme of Delegation are non- Executive functions.**
- (2) That the revised Scheme of Delegation as set out in Appendix B to Document “E” will become operative only if, and when, approved by both Executive and Regulatory and Appeals Committee and the provisions of the previous Scheme of Delegation as set out in Appendix A to Document “E” will then be revoked.**
- (3) That the revised Scheme of Delegation shall remain in force until such time as it may be substituted, modified, varied, or repealed by decisions of the Executive or Regulatory and Appeals Committee or such person or body inheriting the powers of the Executive or Regulatory and Appeals Committee.**
