3. APPLICATION FOR A REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE FOR NAMO MINI MARKET, 13 TOWN GATE, WYKE, BRADFORD, BD12 9PA.
Resolved –

That having considered the Application for Review and all valid representations made by the parties to the hearing; the published statement of licensing policy and relevant statutory guidance; the panel, on the evidence which has been heard, is not satisfied that the Licence Holder has the ability to promote the licensing objectives. Therefore, the panel revokes the Premises Licence in respect of Namo Mini Market, 13 Town Gate, Wyke, Bradford, BD12 9PA.

Reason – It is considered that the revocation is necessary appropriate and proportionate to ensure compliance promotion with of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder and the Public Safety objectives of the Licensing Act 2003.
