## NOTICE OF OBJECTION — Grant of Premises Licence Polandia 57-63 North Parade, Bradford BD1 3JH LICENSING ACT 2003

I refer to the application in respect of the above premises dated 19<sup>TH</sup> October 2016 which was received by the police on 26<sup>th</sup> October 2016

The application is to operate the premises for the sale of alcohol Monday — Sunday 08:00am and midnight.

On 31st October 2016 Bradford District Police Licensing Department served notice onto Bradford Council Licensing Department a number of conditions to be placed onto the Licence if granted.

On 4<sup>th</sup> November 2016 Bradford District Police Licensing Department was notified by H M Revenue & Customs that they had completed a number of Licence Visits in relation to the sale of Illicit

- a) Cigarettes
- b) Hand Rolling Tobacco
- c) Alcohol

One such premises that was visited was POLANDIA (1) POLSKI MINI MARKET 53 North Parade, City Centre, Bradford BD1 3JH.

These premises currently hold a Premises Licence No BD/PRA1459

The owner, Premises Licence Holder and Designated Premises Supervisor being --

## Sangar Sabir OSMAN

Therefore the application now gives rise for concern as follows:-

- Sangar Sabir OSMAN has submitted the application to be the Premises Licence Holder and Designated Premises Supervisor for the Grant of a Premises Licence at Polandia (1) 57 – 63 North Parade, Bradford, BD1 3JH
- Confiscation of a quantity of Illicit Alcohol and Cigarettes at another premises trading and with direct association with this applicant.
- Licensing Objectives None have been fully completed to make assurances of Compliance of the Licensing Act 2003.
- A person to whom subsection (2) applies commits an offence if he knowingly keeps or allow to be kept, on any relevant premises, any goods which have been imported without payment of duty or which have otherwise been unlawfully imported — Sangar Sabir OSMAN has already shown this to be the case at his other Licensed Premises.
- The possession and sale of illegal Alcohol and Cigarettes demonstrates a disregard for the Licensing Objective relating to the Prevention of Crime and Disorder.

The police even though they have requested conditions to be placed onto the Licence are of the opinion that there is now sufficient evidence to submit formal representations against the application on the grounds of - Prevention of Crime and Disorder
