Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence;-
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

(2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children-
 - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to-
 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
 - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
 - (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on-
 - (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
 - (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
 - (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
4. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
5. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

6. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

7. The responsible person shall ensure that-

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-

- (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
- (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

Embedded Conditions

8. None of the restrictions on permitted hours prohibit:

- a. During the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
- b. Consumption of the alcohol on the premises or the taking of the sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises;
- c. The ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
- d. The sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
- e. The sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the supply or sale of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's Naval, Military or Air Forces;
- f. The taking of alcohol from the premises by a person residing there; or
- g. The supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to any private friends of a person residing there who are bona fide entertained by him at his own expense, or the consumption of alcohol by persons so supplied; or
- h. The supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purposes of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, or the consumption of liquor so supplied, if the liquor is supplied at the expense of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises.

- 9. All existing external security lighting shall be maintained in good working order and used where appropriate at all times the premises remain open to the public.
- 10. The Licensee will ensure close liaison with other licensees in the area and will co-operate with any local "Pub

Watch" schemes or similar schemes being promoted by West Yorkshire Police or other local Licensees.

Public Safety:

11. All emergency lighting; illuminated fire exit signs; fire fighting equipment and first aid facilities shall be maintained in good working order and all staff (including temporary staff) adequately trained in their use and about the evacuation procedures for the premises.
12. The Licensee shall provide a plan of the premises to the Licensing Authority and West Yorkshire Fire & Rescue Service, detailing the location and type of all fire safety and other safety equipment, including fire alarms, emergency lighting, fire extinguishers, fire doors and notices, to the satisfaction of West Yorkshire Fire & Rescue Service.

The Prevention of Public Nuisance:

13. Removal of refuse and emptying of bottle bins within the curtilage of the licensed premises shall not take place between the hours of 21.00 and 07.00.
14. The outdoor drinking areas are to be cleared of customers no later than 23.20 hours with prominent appropriate signage displayed encouraging patrons to co-operate with this requirement.
15. The Licensee shall ensure that the kitchen extraction system is maintained in good and effective working order in order to avoid nuisance from smells and noise to neighbouring properties.
16. The Licensee shall maintain working arrangements with local taxi/private hire operators and take reasonable steps to communicate this to patrons in order to ensure orderly booking, arrival and departure of customers in such vehicles.

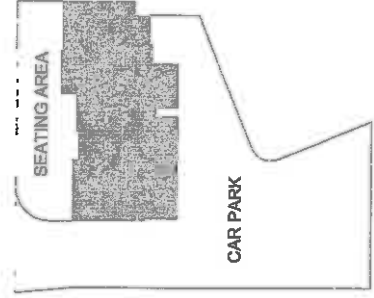
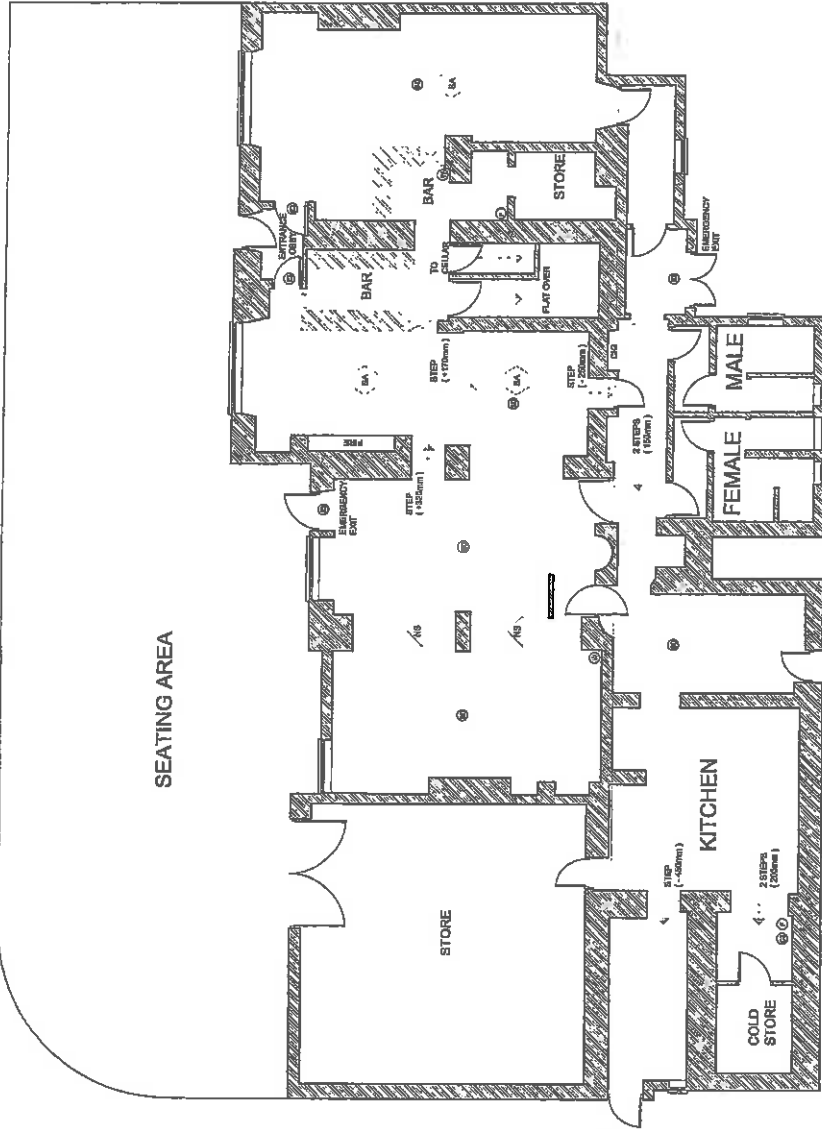
17. Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
18. The Licensee shall enforce an efficient recognised "proof of age policy" at all times and ensure appropriate staffing training in its operation.
19. No regulated entertainment of an adult or sexual nature shall be provided at any time in the licensed premises.
