1. Upon successful grant of this application, premises licence BD/PRA0393 will be surrendered.
2. Any part of the variation application that changes the plan/layout at the premises to be of no effect until the work has been completed.
3. Locations of any fire safety and other safety equipment subject to change in accordance with the requirements of the responsible authorities or following a risk assessment.
4. Any detail shown on the plan that is not required by the licensing plan regulations is indicative only and subject to change.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

1. The premises holder shall be a member of any locally operating Pub Watch scheme.

c) Public safety

1. The DPS/ manager will undertake a weekly inspection of the public areas of the premises to identify anything might present an identifiable risk to public safety.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

1. The collection of refuse, bottles and recyclable materials shall not take place between the hours of 21:00h and 07:00h.
2. The outdoor areas will be closed to customers after 23:30h. Signage will be displayed to this effect.
3. Odour and noise from any flue or kitchen extraction system used for the dispersal of cooking smells serving the building shall not cause nuisance to the occupants of any properties in the vicinity.

e) The protection of children from harm

1. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
2. An approved proof of age scheme shall be adopted, implemented and advertised within the premise such as "Challenge 25" whereby an accepted form of photographic identification shall be requested before any alcohol is sold to any person who appears to be under 25 years of age. Acceptable proof of age shall include identification bearing the customers photograph, date of birth and integral holographic mark or security measure. Suitable means of identification would include PASS approved proof of age card, photo-card driving licence and passport.
