- To represent the residents of Keighley CentralWard to the best of my ability and professionally, ensuring their legitimate concerns are appraised to the relevant department of Bradford Council.
- To continue to hold regularly surgeries in Utley, Town Hall, Highfield Knowle Park Area.
- To continue to liaise with the Police, Traffic Wardens, and the Community Warden.
- Working with the relevant agencies for the elimination of Drug and Anti-Social behaviour.
- Highlight concerns of the community and to promote these at all levels (whenever opportunity is available).
- Work with the Youth Centre and Community Centres.
- To work with Highways re (Gullies and gutters).
- To ensure to resolve issues/concerns in the community and report to the appropriate authorities ie:- Council, Police etc etc.
- Appraise the need of CCTV.
- To work and oversee with the new Traffic project "Hard Ing by pass".
- To work with ward colleagues and support the new community Cemetery at Tarn Keighley. Whilst negotiating the best deal for Utley Cemetery
- To work with KIVCA and KAWACC and other agencies in both Keighley and Bradford on preventative work with women and girls and safe guarding.
- Continue to attend training session as and when they are available, and to attend conferences and seminars, in order to enhance my knowledge and skill.

- As I have the honour of being the Lord Mayor of Bradford for 2018/2019 hence I will
 endeavour to continue my work with my colleagues in Keighley Central Ward.

- To meet with the Police and to have regular contact and give support to the Police in the building of the Keighley Police Station, preferably in the town centre. (The Community do wish the Police Station to be situated in the Town centre as an independent building).
- To attend forums if and when they are held in Keighley Central Ward.
- To support the Friends of Devonshire Park Keighley, Lund Park, and Shared Church/Church Green-Multi-agency working group and to continue to raise anti-social behaviour in the Devonshire Park as well as Cliffe Castle park with the appropriate agency and local residents in the vicinity of the parks.
- To continue to maintain close contact/links with residents in Keighley Central Ward through meetings, forums and via surgeries and meeting residents individually and working with Community centres in Keighley Central ward.
- To participate locally in seminars/conferences and other volunteer organisations.
- To deal with unforseen work. And this is unpredictable.

What I have achieved in the past year (May 2017to May 2018) (Please list or describe some of your activities as a Councillor and what you see as your key achievements)

- Despite the cuts and less resources available many services which directly affect the life of the constituents I have worked hard to maintain and fight for the resources for the constituents of central ward.
- I will continue along with my Ward colleagues to have the best interest of the residents in Keighley Central Ward.
- I have represented constituents on Hackney Carriages Appeals Panel, and made representation at the Hackney Office, Bradford. I have held meetings with officials from Bradford Council together with complainants to resolve the dispute.
- Raised anti-social behaviour in the Keighley Central Ward with the Police and relevant agencies.
- Held numerous meetings with Keighley Police and Warden Officers along with my ward Councillors and co-operating on issues with drugs, traffic, and parking. And peace efforts where it was possible, ensuring Councillors are not Police Officer. Hence appraising the need of the community for prompt action/response.
- North Street Surgery. This was under threat of closure which would have serious
 effects upon patients as well as on staff, and maintain a close link with Local MPs
 office for the support, the threat of closure ceased due to sheer pressures from my
 ward Councillors and the co-operation from the community and volunteers. The issue
 and threat was gone for at least a few years. But the need of a new building is still
 going on.



- I have dealt with a wide range of case work ranging from foot paths, potholes, resurfacing, pavements, planning issues, traffic, parking, fly tipping, domestic bins, trees, blocked gullies and gritting roads/streets in Winter time. Residents parking only and more park space for residents, successfully accomplished. Working together with my ward Councillors we had a successful discussion and positive outcome improving service at Utley Cemetery.
- Arranged Initiatives Clean day and day of action (Cleaning Gullies/Gutters, Litter Picking, Roads/Streets Sweeper.
- Surgeries at Showfield, Lawkholm ,Beechcliffe, Utley, Highfield, Knowle Park. Town centre.
- Fly tipping is a big problem in the Keighley Central Ward and my colleagues and Ward
 Officer are working appraising the residents of its consequences, the work is to
 continue to minimise this issue. Visited numerous residents explaining the law around
 fly tipping.
- Arranged a Street Walk with MP's Staff, Ward Officer, CSOs, Councillors, and Volunteers, Officer from Crime Buster (How to report the incidence in complete confidence) and local residents to appraise and co-operation for elimination of the drug plight in the area.
- Distributing leaflets and speaking to individuals on the harmful effects of the misuse of the substance on the family and in the community. Ensuring Councillors are not Police Officers but working together with the Community/Volunteers and like minded people who care about the community and area where they live. We had a good response to some extent but the work continues.
