**STATEMENT OF REPRESENTATIONS PROCEDURE**

Title of documents	Addingham Neighbourhood Development Plan
Subject Matter	Addingham Parish Council has produced a proposed Neighbourhood Development Plan which covers the Addingham Parish Council boundary. The Plan contains a vision for Addingham along with a set of objectives, planning policies and proposals to achieve the vision. The planning policies within the Plan seek to protect the character of Addingham with policies guiding new development, including housing, Addingham local businesses and community facilities, employment opportunities, improve transport network, as well as protection policies relating to local greenspaces and resilience to climate change.
Area covered	Addingham Parish Council boundary (and Neighbourhood Area boundary) which lies within the City of Bradford Metropolitan District
Consultation period	Written comments are invited during the 8 week consultation period commencing on Wednesday 14 <sup>th</sup> November 2018 and concluding at 12pm on Wednesday 9 <sup>th</sup> January 2019.

Under Regulation 15 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, Addingham Parish Council has submitted its proposed Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) to the City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council.

In accordance with Regulation 16, Bradford Council will publish the Addingham Neighbourhood Development Plan, Proposals Map, Basic Conditions Statement, Statement of Consultation, Strategic Environmental Assessment & Habitats Regulations Assessment and an Equality Impact Assessment for comment on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2018. Comments are invited and encouraged on the Comment Form provided.

Representations must be received by 12pm on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2019 via the methods outlined above.

**Group Responses** - Where there are groups who share a common view on how they wish to see the Plan changed, it would be very helpful for that group to submit a single representation which represents the view of the group, rather than separate individual representations which repeat the same points. In such cases the group should indicate how many people it is representing and how the representation has been authorised.
