## INFORMATIONAL FLYER TO THE RESIDENTS SURROUNDING THE CLUB

Please be aware of the situation developing at **Leicester Street Community Club**, and previously called East Bowling Unity Club.

Their new name seems to give a false impression that this Club's officials care about the surrounding neighbourhood and residents.

They apparently do not, because they now wish to apply for a change of premises permit from a CLUB (Members and specified Guests ONLY) to a PUBLIC HOUSE permits for alcohol & entertainment.

It is a change to a less restrictive license, opening up the CLUB to anyone, and allowing potentially longer and later hours of operation.

Do we local residents want potentially **unaccountable** drunks wondering our streets, in East Bowling, after midnight?

This Club's building is surrounded on all four sides by residential housing.

The front side (the Leicester Street side) is mostly "senior citizen" housing.

I personally feel this change of usage permit, should not be allowed by the Council Planning department. .

There are still a few residents who purchased their houses, before the Club was originally built and also helped build up the old Club's assets. (Have these assets been squandered?)

Do you think the Club is alienating its local residents, and old members?
