I understand that there is a possibility that Leicester Street Community Club may close down due to a complaint from a local resident. Please can I ask you to reconsider. I have run 3 Slimming World Groups in this venue for nearly 12 months with approximately 120+ members of the local community. A lot of my members are able to walk here with being local to East Bowling and the Club is a local hub of activity to them. Many also attend for various reasons eg bingo, weddings, funerals, parties, charity events, pensioners groups, sports events etc etc.

During my time here, I have not encountered any problems with the Club or the people attending it. I can honestly say I feel safe here

There is a lack of venues in East Bowling that can house the size of my Groups and therefore, if the Club was to close, I would lose my business that I have built up over the last 23 and a half years. I feel sure a lot of people would lose out if the Club were to close and many people would lose their livelihoods as well as the social interactions the Club provides.

As for gathering outside there maybe 3-4 people using the smoking shed and and a
few standing on the side walk waiting for transport home chatting but well behaved.
