a) General - all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e)

List here steps you will take to promote all four licensing objectives together.

I am proposing to open a micro pub which sells mainly real ale from local breweries. I hope to attract discerning drinkers out for a quiet drink. I am aware of my responsibilites as the DPS and will be implementing a sensible drinking policy. I will undertake ongoing risk assessments as public safety is my main concern. I will keep noise to a minimum and liaise with my neighbours. There will be no amplified music or fruit machines.

#### b) The prevention of crime and disorder

I will display challenge 21 notice. A notice will also be displayed stating that drug use and violent anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated on the premises. I will have CCTV and main door access to street lighting. I will liaise with any pub watch scheme and I will be happy to take further guidance from local police on this matter. I will discourage binge drinking and promotional drink offers.

#### c) Public safety

I will conduct ongoing health & safety and fire risk assessments as well as first aid training. I will install CCTV cameras, emergency lighting and smoke detectors. A log book will be maintained that regular checks to alarm and electrical appliances are all in working order.

## d) The prevention of public nuisance

I intend to sell alcohol within times that do not exceed normal trading hours. All deliveries and rubbish disposal will be during the day. There is no kitchen or food sold on the premises. There will be no external fans.

Notices on the door will ask patrons to leave quietly and respectfully.

# e) The protection of children from harm

There will be no adult entertainment or gambling and a challenge 21 policy will be in place. I will comply with any conditions the authority has made but think it would be reasonable to allow children accompanied by an adult on the premises until 6pm each evening.

I think a sensible drinking approach will ensure children are not exposed to any violence or disorder.
