I would like to object on the grounds of the following

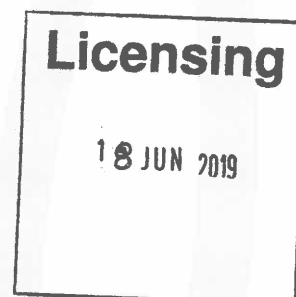
1. The prevention of crime and disorder

Greys Nursing has been trading on North Parade for over 30 years, we employ over 100 people in Bradford. Our staff are paid on the submission of timesheets for work carried out. Unfortunately last year during the "street party" on North Parade, we had a large number of staff who were unable to drop their timesheets off due to the crowds of "party goers" who were drunk and intimidating them. We frequently arrive at our office on a Monday morning to be greeted with empty bottles, half-drunk pint glassed and vomit. At one point we were even greeted with a used needle.

My concern is, if it is not controlled on a regular weekend how is it going to be controlled on a weekend specifically designed to encourage people to drink excessively. The Street party is mainly to increase the licenced businesses profits, and all it does for the rest of the businesses on the street is cause worry and disruption.

I also have concerns surrounding the position of the stage, The stage will emanate loud music throughout the street, the building at the side of ours so number 10 North Parade, currently has no tenant in due to the fact the upper floor external wall is bowing towards the street. I am not a surveyor but I do worry about the possibility of the wall falling down due to the vibrations.
