#### **Public Space Protection Order Survey Analysis 2019**

A total of 71 online surveys were submitted with 34 people (48%) completed the survey on the City Centre, 19 people (27%) on Keighley Town Centre, 8 people (11%) on Bingley town centre, 8 people (11%) on Shipley town centre and 2 people (3%) on West Bowling. 56% of respondents had visited the exclusion zone within the last 6 months, 51% live outside of the exclusion zone, 39% work in the exclusion zone and only 11% live in the exclusion zone. 75% of respondents were aware that the Council introduced this PSPO in April 2017.

41% of respondents said that the level of alcohol related anti-social behaviour has reduced since the PSPO was introduced (35% think it is the same and 23% think it has increased).


When considering how safe they felt within the exclusion zone 20% of respondents reported feeling safer, 56% haven't noticed any difference and 23% feel no safer.

Those respondents who reported feeling safer said they found the PSPO visibility reassuring, there was a reduced level of harassment from people asking for money for alcohol, the regular patrols and greater use of door staff at troubled locations is reassuring and more generally people appreciated the effort being made to reduce anti-social behaviour.

Respondents reporting no change in their feeling of safety said that the problem remains with some feeling that it has been dispersed to other areas.

When considering how safe they felt in areas of Bradford outside the exclusion zone 54% of respondents said they felt safe compared to 18% who said they felt unsafe (23% felt neither and 4% said they didn't go to areas outside the exclusion zone).

Since April 2017 42% of respondents have visited the exclusion zone at least once a week (39% have visited every day). Fewer people visited the exclusion zone in the evening (from 5pm-midnight) than any other time of day. The busiest time for people to visit was Sunday afternoon (from 12:01pm to 5pm).



In addition to the 71 responses received via the online survey written support for the continuation of the PSPO has been received from the Police and Crime Commissioner for West Yorkshire, Bradford District Chamber of Trade, Bradford Business Improvement District (BID) (who would like to see an increase in the number of dedicated PSPO officers) and Cllr Martin Love and Cllr Kevin Warnes for the Green Party (who propose that the Shipley Town Centre order be extended as far as the Bingley Road / Hirst Lane junction, thereby incorporating Gordon Terrace and the Hop at the far end of Saltaire).

Aggressive and dangerous driving makes me feel uncomfortable walking, especially on and near Manningham (although I have observed this throughout the area). I have seen an increase in illegal vehicles being driven at speed on main roads. I have also noticed a marked increase of homeless people at intersections and walking along the roads asking for money, and although I'm sure most are perfectly harmless, it does tend to make people feel unsafe. Lastly, I've seen much more drugs- and alcohol-related litter, including nitrous capsules, needles and loads of liquor bottles. I have seen these around schools many, many times.








