## Sufficiency of Specialist places for Children and Young People with SEND

## **Abbey Green and Midland Road Nursery Schools**

The Local Authority has a statutory duty to keep under review the specialist provision it makes for children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND). We also must ensure there are sufficient specialist places available to meet the needs of the growing SEND population.

In 2019/2020 we propose to increase the amount of specialist places available through a range of services by expanding and developing 354 additional specialist provision places to enhance the network of Special Schools, Early Years Enhanced Specialist provision (EYESPs), Designated Specialist Provision (DSPs, now known as Resource Provision – School Led) Pupil Referral Units (PRUs) and create new Resourced Provisions (RP) both LA Led and School Led places that are required to meet the current and future needs of children and young people with a range of Special Educational Needs and Disabilities.

This is a pre-consultation to gain the views of parents/carers and all interested parties on the proposals for the reduction of places in the Early Years Enhanced Specialist provision (EYESP) at Abbey Green Nursery School and the development of new EYESP places at Midland Road Nursery School.
