APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE 15 FEBRUARY 2020 for THE VIEW MARQUEE, 119 WESTGATE HILL STREET, TONG, BRADFORD, BD4 OSE

This Department is in receipt of on-going complaints regarding noise nuisance caused by the playing or performance of loud amplified music at The View Marquee, 119 Westgate Hill Street, Tong, Bradford, BD4 0SE.

An Abatement Notice, numbered POL/474301/1 was served on 16 August 2019 and is still active. Despite the service of the Abatement Notice, Environmental Health has evidence that it has been continually contravened when events take place in the View Marquee, from the amplification of loud music.

On 24 January 2020, L & C Leisure Ltd withdrew their Appeal against the service of the Abatement Notice. This Department's Legal Counsel advised the appellant's solicitor that this Department is considering further formal action due to the contraventions of the Abatement Notice.

It should also be noted that the View Marquee is an unauthorised structure which Planning Enforcement are currently dealing with. This case is due to be heard in court on Tuesday 28 February 2020.

This being the case, Environmental Health would not support the TENS application or future applications unless it can be demonstrated that noise arising from the events will not cause a disturbance to nearby noise sensitive dwellings.

The investigation is still on-going.
