**Licensing Act 2003
Application for Premises Licence
Wyke Rose, 435, Huddersfield Road, Wyke, Bradford, BD12 8NP**

I have concerns about the granting of a new Premises Licence for the above premises. As you are aware this Department reviewed the previous premises licence on 2 separate occasions and it was subsequently revoked due to on-going issues with noise from the premises.

I acknowledge that the current application is for the sale of alcohol only however, the introduction of the Live Music Act 2012 means that live music can be played within the premises between 08:00 and 23:00 hours for up to 500 people without the need for a licence.

I would therefore ask that you dis-apply the live music exemption under the Live Music Act 2012 and make live music at the Wyke Rose a licensable activity at all times.
