

This license is a grant which allows the opening of a late night refreshment from Monday - Sunday 23:00 - 02:00; Ramadan 23:00 - 05:00.

Noise Nuisance

As a local resident of the above address, the main road already causes a lot of noise nuisance due to the sheer amount of cars that travel on this road after daylight hours. The opening of this business would simply increase the level of noise as there would be more cars/people waiting around this area. This effects residence as people cannot sleep at night and have to be up for work in the morning!!

Blocking view of traffic
