NOTICE is hereby given that City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council proposes to make the above Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the general effect of which will be to introduce a 20 miles per hour speed limit zones within the Parkwood Street Area on the following roads:-

Parkwood Street, Quarry Street, Tyne Street, Carlisle Street, Haynes Street, Dundas Street, Napier Street, Alpha street, Dean's Lathe, Leyland Lane, Brow Street, Feather Street, St Paul's Road, Moore Street, Kendal Street.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

As part of the locally determined safety schemes programme for 2020/2021, The City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council is proposing to introduce further traffic calming on Parkwood Street, from its junction with Park Lane to its junction with Quarry Street, which will include provision of speed cushions and a 20 miles per hour speed limit zone within the Parkwood Street Area. The proposed restrictions around St Paul's Road have already been consulted therefore they are not part of this scheme.

The extent of the restrictions are shown on Drawing No:- P/HS/ THN/104842/ Consultation

The Council considers it expedient to make this Order:-

- i. for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the roads or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; and
- ii. for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:-

PART I SPEED LIMIT RESTRICTION

 No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order

PART II SPECIAL FORCES EXEMPTION

 No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

PART III

GENERAL

- 3. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road where the context requires it. The lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order are shown for illustrative purposes only on drawing numbers:- P/HS/THN/104842/Consultation annexed hereto.
- 4. Where an Act of Parliament referred to in this Order or any Regulation Direction or Order made under it is repealed and new provisions enacted (with or without modifications) then the new provisions shall be substituted in this Order where relevant.
- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.
- 6. This Order is made on the ** day of ********* and shall come into force on the **** day of ******** and may be cited as the "City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council (Speed Limit) (No 4) Order 2020".
