Licensing Act 2003 Review of Premises Licence Treehouse Bar & Kitchen, Oak Street, Haworth

I support the above application for a review of the Premises Licence for the Treehouse Bar & Kitchen, Oak Street, Haworth.

Environmental Health has received at least 7 complaints relating to noise from the premises since 15th July 2021. The complaints relate to excessive noise from the playing of amplified music, shouting, screaming and chanting in the outside area, noise from people using the smoking shelter, slamming car doors, taxis reversing up the street at speed late at night and also noise from the extraction system in the early hours of the morning.

The premises are located in a mixed use area but in close proximity to residential dwellings. The previous use of the premises was as a restaurant and Environmental Health do not appear to have received any complaints relating to noise from the premises or customers.

I would therefore suggest the opening hours are reduced as follows:

- Monday to Sunday 10:00 -23:00 hours

I would also recommend the following conditions are applied to the Premises Licence:

- Notices shall be displayed in prominent positions near exits reminding patrons to respect the neighbours and leave in a quiet and orderly manner.
- All outward opening exit doors and all windows are to be kept closed when amplified regulated entertainment is taking place except for access and egress.
- Noise from the provision of regulated entertainment shall be inaudible at the nearest noise sensitive premises.
- The external areas should be cleared of customers no later than 22:00 hours
